Police Standing Orders.

Principal
orders.

1. In these standing orders the Police Standing Orders, 1968, as printed in the *Government Gazette* on the 22nd July, 1968, and also published in the *Special Police Gazette* on the 7th August, 1968, and thereafter amended from time to time by notices so printed and published, are referred to as the principal orders.

amended.

2. Suborder (1) of order 1104 of the principal orders is amended by substituting for the passage commencing with the word "Commissioner" in line four and ending with the word "metal" being the last word in the suborder, a passage as follows:—

Commissioner—crossed batons in a laurel wreath surmounted by a crown, silvered metal.

Deputy Commissioner—crossed batons in a laurel wreath surmounted by a star, silvered metal.

Assistant Commissioner—crossed batons in a laurel wreath, silvered metal.

Chief Superintendent—2 stars surmounted by a crown, silvered metal.

Superintendent—1 star surmounted by a crown, silvered metal.

Senior Inspector—1 crown, silvered metal.

Inspector—3 stars, silvered metal.

3. Item 3 of Schedule 2 to the principal orders is amended—

(a) by substituting for the passage ", officer's badge, and for Senior Inspector and Inspector plain black peak." in lines four and five the following—

"with officer's badge.

Senior Inspector and Inspector cap peak to have a single row of silver embroidery $\frac{3}{8}$ inch wide."; and

(b) by substituting for the illustrations 1 to 10, illustrations as follows—

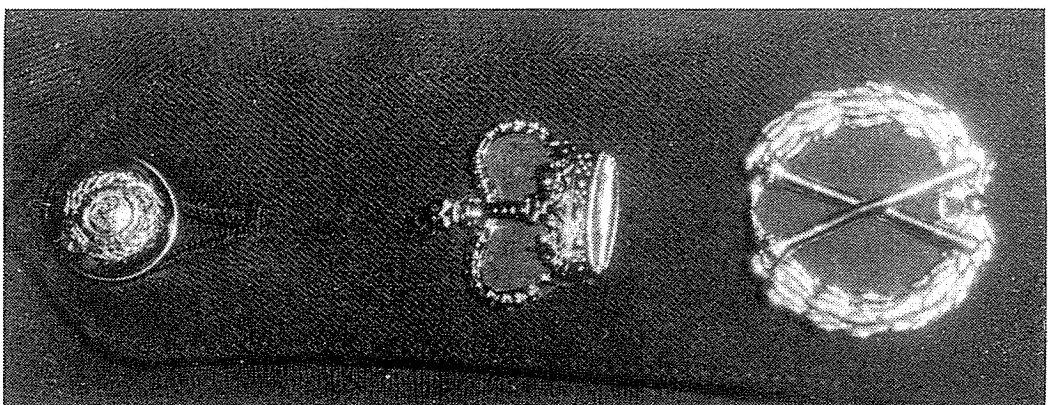

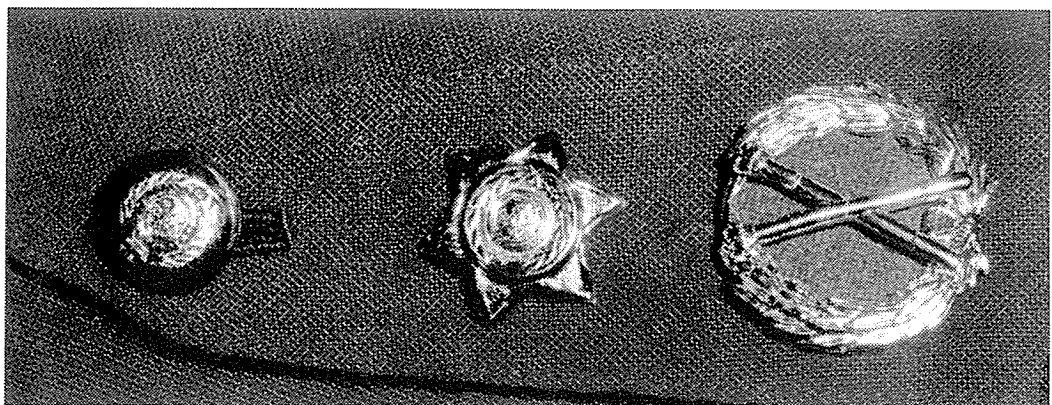

ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER OF POLICE

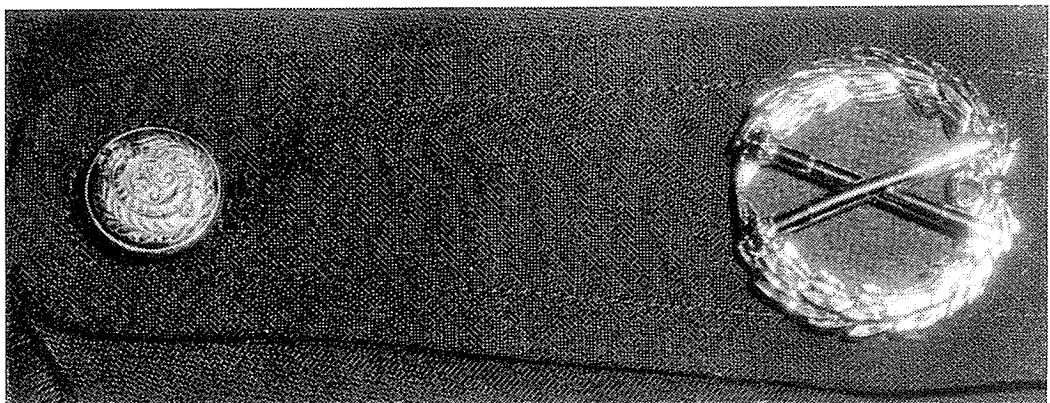
