TAXI-CARS (CO-ORDINATION AND CONTROL) ACT, 1963-1973.

Transport Commission, Nedlands, 27th July, 1973.

Principal Regulations.

1. In these regulations the Taxi-cars Regulations, 1964 as reprinted pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act, 1954 and published in the Government Gazette on the 4th March, 1970, with amendments up to and including the 9th November, 1969, and amended from time to time thereafter by notices so published, are referred to as the principal regulations.

Part X amended.

- 2. Part X of the principal regulations is amended-
 - (a) by substituting for Appendix A an appendix as follows:—
