Public and Bank Holidays Act, 1972. PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, {By His Excellency Air Commodore Hughie Idwal To Wit: JEdwards, Victoria Cross, Companion of the Most H. I. EDWARDS, Governor. [L.S.] Excellent Order of the Bath, Companion of the Distinguished Service Order, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Dis-tinguished Flying Cross, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

PURSUANT to the provisions of subsection (2) of section 7 of the Public and Bank Holidays Act, 1972, I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby cancel the proclamation published in the Government Gazette on the 18th January, 1974 appointing the 5th March, 1974 a public and bank holiday throughout the State and declaring that such public holiday is to celebrate the visit to this State in 1974 of Our Sovereign Lady Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this 8th day of February, Nineteen hundred and seventyfour.
