PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, } By His Excellency Air Chief Marshal Sir Wallace
To Wit: } Kyle, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Honourable
WALLACE KYLE, } Order of the Bath, Commander of the Most
Governor. } Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion
[L.S.] } of the Distinguished Service Order, Distinguished
Flying Cross, Knight of Grace of the Most
Venerable Order of the Hospital of St. John of
Jerusalem, Governor in and over the State of
Western Australia and its Dependencies in the
Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS under the provisions of section three of the Constitution Act, 1889-1970, it is lawful for the Governor to prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly, from time to time, and to dissolve the Legislative Assembly by proclamation or otherwise whenever he shall think fit: Now, therefore, I, the Governor, in the exercise of the powers conferred by the Act, do hereby declare and proclaim that the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly shall stand prorogued as from the fifth day of January, Nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, and that the Legislative Assembly shall be dissolved as from that date.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State at Perth, this fifth day of January, Nineteen hundred and seventy-seven.
