PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA,
To Wit:
WALLACE KYLE,
Governor.

Kyle, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Honourable
Order of the Bath, Knight Commander of the

Jerusalem, Governor in and over the State of
Western Australia and its dependencies in the
Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS under the provisions of section three of the Constitution Act, 1889-1979, it is lawful for the Governor to prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly, from time to time, and to dissolve the Legislative Assembly by proclamation or otherwise whenever he shall think fit. Now, therefore, I the Course is the fit of the course of fit: Now, therefore, I, the Governor, in the exercise of the powers conferred by the Act, do hereby declare and proclaim that the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly shall stand prorogued as from the ninth day of January, Nineteen hundred and eighty, and that the Legislative Assembly shall be dissolved as from that date.
