## REGULATIONS.

- Citation. 1. These regulations may be cited as the Company Take-overs Act (Western Australia) Regulations, 1980.
- Interpretation and forms. 2. (1) In these regulations, "the Act" means the Company Take-overs Act, 1979, and words, expressions and designations used in the Act have the same meanings as those given to them in and for the purposes of the Act.
- (2) Pursuant to section 5 of the Act the provisions of the Companies Regulations, 1976, apply to and in relation to the Act and these regulations.
- (3) Subject to these regulations, where a provision of the Act or of these regulations is specified in the first column of the First Schedule to these regulations, the form set out in the Second Schedule to these regulations the designation of which is specified in the third column of the First Schedule opposite to that provision is prescribed as the form to be used for the purposes of that provision in relation to the matter or thing described in the second column of the First Schedule opposite to that provision.
- (4) Strict compliance with the forms contained in the Second Schedule to these regulations is not necessary, and substantial compliance is sufficient.
- (5) Where a form prescribed by these regulations requires completion by the insertion of, or the attachment to the form of, a document containing particulars or other matters referred to in the form, those particulars or other matters are prescribed as the particulars or other matters required under the provisions of the Act or of these regulations for the purposes for which the form is prescribed.
- (6) A form prescribed by these regulations shall be completed in accordance with such directions as are specified in the form as so prescribed.
- Prescribed Stock Exchanges. 3. For the purposes of the Act each body corporate set out below is declared to be a stock exchange, namely—  
The Stock Exchange of Adelaide Limited.  
The Brisbane Stock Exchange Limited.  
The Hobart Stock Exchange.  
The Stock Exchange of Melbourne Limited.  
The Stock Exchange of Perth Limited.  
The Sydney Stock Exchange Limited.
- Prescribed offices under s. 9 (7) (b). 4. For the purposes of paragraph (b) of subsection (7) of section 9 of the Act the following offices are prescribed offices—  
(a) the office of Treasurer of the State;  
(b) the office of Commissioner for Corporate Affairs;  
(c) the office of trustee under, or continued under, Parts IV and X of the Bankruptcy Act 1966 of the Commonwealth;  
(d) the office of Official Receiver under the Bankruptcy Act 1966 of the Commonwealth;  
(e) the office of Public Trustee under the Public Trustee Act, 1941;  
(f) the office of Master and the office of Registrar of the Supreme Court within the meaning of the Supreme Court Act, 1935;  
(g) the Controller of Enemy Property holding office under the National Security (Enemy Property) Regulations of the Commonwealth; and  
(h) any office in another State or Territory of the Commonwealth corresponding to an office referred to in paragraph (a), (b), (e), or (f).

5. Pursuant to paragraph (a) of subsection (11) of section 27 of the Act, where an offeror purports to vary an offer under a take-over scheme in the manner referred to in subsection (7) of that section, then the notice which is required to be sent to each person to whom an offer under the take-over scheme was made shall set out, except in so far as such matters—

- (a) were set out in that offer or in the relevant part A statement;
  - (b) have not changed since the date of the making of that offer or the service of the relevant Part A statement; and
  - (c) are not to be changed by the proposed variation,
- the following information—

- (i) the period during which the offer is intended to remain open, ending on a specified date, being a date not later than 12 months after the date that the offer bears;
- (ii) any information which the offeror would have been required to include in the relevant Part A statement, had such a statement been served on the date of the variation of the offer; and
- (iii) any other information material to the making of a decision by an offeree whether or not to accept an offer, being information that is within the knowledge of the offeror and has not previously been disclosed to the holders of shares in the target company.

6. The fee to be paid pursuant to section 36 of the Act to a company on a request to supply a written statement of the names and addresses of certain persons shall be payable at the rate of fifty cents, or such less sum as the company requires, for every hundred words or part thereof.

Fees.

7. (1) Subject to subregulation (2) of this regulation, the fees payable for the purposes of the Act are the fees respectively specified in the Third Schedule to these regulations in respect of the matters in relation to which they are so specified.

(2) Where the Commissioner is satisfied that any fee that would otherwise be payable in accordance with item 11 in the Third Schedule is not warranted by the work involved, the Commissioner may waive that part of the fee payable in respect to that item which exceeds fifty dollars.

8. Where any documents are required by the Act to be registered or lodged, those documents shall be placed by the Commissioner on the file appropriate to the relevant target company.

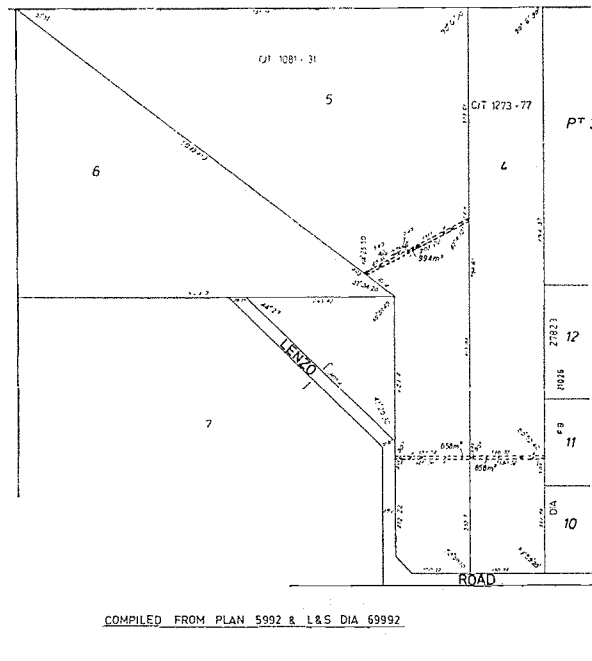
