#### ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1974.

## ROAD TRAFFIC (INFRINGEMENTS) REGULATIONS 1975.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Infringements) Citation. Regulations 1975.

2. In these regulations, unless a contrary intention appears—

Interpre-tation.

"Act" means the Road Traffic Act 1974;

"Schedule" means a Schedule to these regulations.

3. The offences described in the First Schedule are those prescribed for the purposes of section 102 of the Act and the amount appearing in the final column of that Schedule, directly opposite an offence, is the prescribed penalty in respect of that offence, if dealt with under that

4. For the purposes of subsections (3) and (5) of section 102 of the Act, a prescribed officer is any commissioned officer of Police serving with the Road Patrol and, in a district to which section 110 of the Act applies, the traffic inspector, or where there is more than one, the senior traffic inspector for the district.

5. (1) Subject to subregulation (2) of this regulation, an officer specified in an infringement notice as an officer to whom payment of a prescribed penalty may be made shall not accept payment of the prescribed penalty unless it appears to him that the number and particulars of the offender's motor driver's licence have been indorsed on the infringement notice by a patrolman, an officer of the Crown Law Department authorized in that behalf by the Authority or an Amended by G.G. 28/5/7 (2) Subregulation (1) of this regulation does not apply to an infringenent notice issued in respect of—

(a) an offence of which the officer of the Authority.

A person who, not being a patrolman, makes any indorsement on, Offence of or alteration to, an infringement notice commits an offence. Penalty: One hundred dollars.

7. The several forms set out in the Second Schedule are prescribed Forms. for the respective purposes for which forms are required by the provisions of section 102 of the Act.

(1) The Traffic (Infringements) Regulations 1974, and all Revocation and saving. amendments thereto are revoked.

(2) Notwithstanding the revocation provided by subregulation (1) of this regulation, a prescribed officer, within the meaning of the Traffic (Infringements) Regulations 1974, may inflict and collect penalties under those regulations in respect of offences committed before the commencement of these regulations.
