## **PROCLAMATION**

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Rear-Admiral Sir Richard John
To Wit:
RICHARD Victorian Order, Knight of Grace of the Most

Venerable Order of the Hospital of St. John of
Jerusalem, Governor in and over the State of
Western Australia and its Dependencies in the
Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 2 of the Transport Amendment Act 1981 that the provisions of that Act shall come into operation on such day or days as is or are respectively fixed by proclamation: Now therefore I, the Governor acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby fix 8 June 1981 as the day on which all the provisions of the Transport Amendment Act 1981, other than section 3, shall come into operation.
