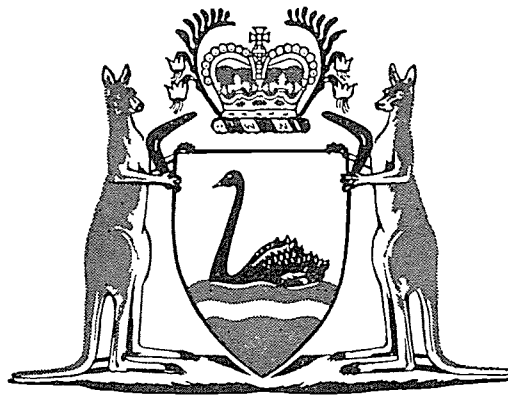

The following amendments are to be made by deleting the old charge and inserting the new charge as shown.

Page 13	Clause 19(e) Transshipping of overloaded wagons at cost—amend maximum charge to read \$2.50 per tonne.
Page 17	Clause 24(b) Delete and insert in lieu :— (b) Where loads exceeding the prescribed height and/or width set down in subclause (d) of this clause are carried, an “out of gauge” charge of \$30 per wagon shall be raised. Alternatively the Marketing Manager may quote specially or may charge on the basis of actual cost of special working plus 30%.
Page 20	Clause 28 Where destination of traffic is altered in transit—amend charges to read:— Subclause (b) \$3.50 per four or eight wheeled wagon Subclause (c) \$2.50 per consignment of less than wagonloads.
Page 22	Clause 31(a) (v) and (b) (iii) Lifting charges for approved containers—amend charges to read \$1.40 per tonne.
Pages 27–42	Clause 42 Classification of general goods—amend Class column as follows:—
Page 33	Fruit, fresh, single bag, carton or case lots—maximum \$2 per single lot.
Page 45	Vegetables, fresh, single bag, carton or case lots—maximum \$2 per single lot.
Pages 47–49	Clause 61. Distance Rates. Preamble relating to deregulated area rates. In last line of second paragraph, after the word “herein” add “except that a surcharge may be added to gazetted by-law rates when ‘to door’ delivery is performed by Westrail Road Services.” Insert new distance rates as per attached schedule.
Page 50	Clause 62 Insert new rates for small consignments as per attached schedule.
Page 52	Clause 64. Road Services. Para (c)—Amend surcharge for safety vehicle to read 90 cents per kilometre. Para (d)—Amend demurrage charge to read \$11.50 per trailer for each 8 working hours or part. Para (e)—Amend off-route charge to read 90 cents per kilometre. Para (f)—Amend waiting time charges as follows:— (i) Rigid vehicles \$2.90 per 15 minutes or part. When additional labour supplied, the charge will be increased to \$4.10 per 15 minutes or part. (ii) Semi-trailers \$2.90 per 10 minutes or part. When additional labour supplied, the charge will be increased to \$3.70 per 10 minutes or part.

- Effective 1/7/81. Consignments of wool from the Eneabba area—defined as:—
“That area bounded on the West by the coast; on the South by the Coorow-
Greenhead Road; on the East by a line running West of, and parallel to,
but at no point closer than 32 kilometres from the Coorow-Mingenew rail-
way line and; on the North by a line running South of and parallel to, but at
no point closer than 32 kilometres from the Mingenew-Dongara railway
line”.
- The area is dissected into two zones using the Three Springs to Leeman Road. That
area within the boundary and South of this roadway will be known as Zone 1
and that area North thereof known as Zone 2; for rating purposes.
- The bale rates shown in Clause 63, page 51 include components for off-route run-
ning, waiting time and Metropolitan delivery as required.
