## EDUCATION ACT 1928-1979.

## EDUCATION ACT AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No. 8) 1981.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Act Amendment Regulations (No. 8) 1981.
- 2. In these regulations the Education Act Regulations 1960\* as amended are referred to as the principal regulations.
  - 3. Regulation 31 of the principal regulations is amended—
    - (a) by inserting before "A" the following-
      - " (1) "; and
    - (b) by inserting the following subregulation-
      - (2) A teacher shall not fail to carry out his normal teaching duties in represent of his purils." in respect of his pupils.
- 4. The principal regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 31 the following regulation-
  - 31A. (1) A teacher shall not encourage, counsel or incite a parent to withhold his child from attending school.
    - (2) A teacher shall not during normal school hours encourage, counsel or incite another teacher from a school other than the school to which the first-mentioned teacher is appointed not to carry out his normal teaching duties.
  - 5. Regulation 134 of the principal regulations is amended—
    - (a) by inserting after subregulation (5) the following subregulation—
      - (5a) Notwithstanding subregulation (5) of this regulation, where as a result of an inquiry the Director-General determines that a teacher is guilty of misconduct that consists of an offence against regulation 31A (2) of these regulations the Director-General may—
        - (a) by order in writing do one or both of the following, namely—
          - (i) reduce the teacher from one position to another carrying a lower salary or remuneration;
          - (ii) subject to subregulation (8) of this regulation, suspend the teacher for any period up to 12 months; or
        - (b) make a report and recommendation to the Minister that the teacher be dismissed. "; and
    - teacher be dismissed. "; and

      (b) in subregulation (6), by inserting after "(5) of this regulation" the following—

      " or paragraph (b) of subregulation (5a) of this regulation, as the case
