- These regulations may be cited as the Transfer of Land Act Regulations Citation. 1972.
- 2. The Transfer of Land Act Regulations published in the Government Revocation. Gazette on the 16th March, 1951, and amended from time to time thereafter by notices so published, are revoked.

3. (1) Every document presented for registration or lodgment in the Office of Titles shall comply with the following requirements:—

Requirements as to documents.

(a) it shall be prepared on good quality paper approved by the Registrar and having the dimensions 337 millimetres by 210 millimetres;

- (aa) if on a form other than those available from the Government Printer, it shall be in a form approved by the Registrar;
- (b) it shall be clearly and legibly handwritten in ink, printed, or type-
- (c) all writing, printing, type, or other matter appearing on the document shall be of sufficient strength to bear photographic reproduction;
- (d) the signature of any party to the document, and that of any witness to such signature, shall be written in ink;
- (e) where the document consists of more than one page, the pages shall be bound together in a manner acceptable to the Registrar; and
- (f) after 1 July 1981, all forms other than those printed by the Govern-ment Printer shall bear the impression or printing of the Registrar's approval number at the foot of the first page.
- (2) The Registrar may reject for registration or lodgment a document that does not comply with this regulation.
- 4. (1) The Registrar may refuse to issue a Certificate of Title for more than one lot on a plan or diagram of subdivision.

(2) Where an application is made for a Certificate of Title for the land which is the subject of a plan or diagram of subdivision the Registrar may if he thinks fit, after issuing the Certificate of Title so applied for, issue a Certificate of Title for each lot or any number of lots on that plan or diagram and cancel the Certificate of Title so applied for and issued to such extent as is necessary.

Issue of Certificates of Title for lots on plans or diagrams.

5. (1) Where an application is made for a Certificate of Title for the whole or part of the land the subject of any existing Certificate or Certificates of Title for Title the Registrar may if he thinks fit, instead of issuing the Certificate of Title for Title so applied for, issue a Certificate of Title for each lot or for any number of lots included in that land.

(2) If the Registrar is satisfied that a Certificate of Title is too full for Amended by further endorsement he may issue a new Certificate of Title without payment G.G. 10/10/80, of a separate fee for a new Certificate of Title.
