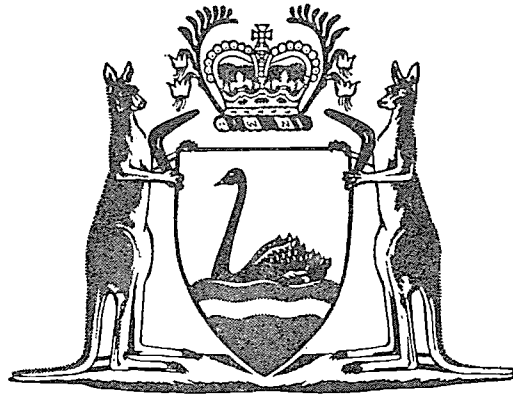

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1974-1980.

ROAD TRAFFIC (INFRINGEMENTS) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No. 3) 1981.

MADE by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

- Citation. 1. These regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Infringements) Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 1981.
- Principal regulations. 2. In these regulations the Road Traffic (Infringements) Regulations 1975*, as amended, are referred to as the principal regulations.
- First Schedule substituted. 3. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is deleted and the following Schedule is substituted—

ROAD TRAFFIC CODE AMENDMENT (No. 8) 1981.

Citation. 1. These regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic Code Amendment (No. 8) 1981.
