ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act 1933, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any Reserve shall vest in and be held by any person or persons to be named in the order in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order: And whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 37600 should vest in and be held by Shire of Mount Marshall in trust for the purpose of "Airstrip".

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby direct that the beforementioned Reserve shall vest in and be held by Shire of Mount Marshall in trust for the purpose aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 288 of the Local Government Act 1960-1981, it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request by a Council of a Municipal District, by Order published in the *Government Gazette* to declare any lands reserved or acquired for use by the public or used by the public as a street, way, public place, bridge or thoroughfare, under the care, control, and management of the Council, or lands comprised in a private street, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of the Council, or lands comprised in a private street, or which the public has had uninterrupted use for a period of not less than ten years, as a public street and if the Council thinks fit, that the Governor shall declare the width of carriageway and footpaths of the public street; and whereas the Councils mentioned in the schedule hereto have requested that certain lands named and described in the said schedule, which have been reserved for streets within the said Councils, be declared public streets: Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare the said lands to be public streets and such land shall, from the date of this Order, be absolutely dedicated to the public as streets within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.

 - (ii) The member polling the lowest number of votes shall hold office until the close of the next but one succeeding annual general meeting, and in the case of a tie, the returning officer shall decide the issue.
 - (iii) In the event of there being no ballot, the time for retirement shall be settled by lot.
- (b) At the second annual general meeting held after the coming into effect of this by-law the five members of Committee due to retire shall retire, and five members shall be elected in accordance with the preceding by-law, and shall hold office as follows:—
 - (i) The three members polling the highest number of votes shall hold office until the close of the next but two succeeding annual general meetings, and in case of a tie, the returning officer shall decide the issue.
 - (ii) The two members polling the lowest number of votes shall hold office until the close of the next succeeding annual general meeting, and in the case of a tie, the returning officer shall decide the issue.
 - (iii) In the event of there being no ballot, the time for retirement shall be settled by lot.
- (c) At the third annual general meeting held after the coming into effect of this by-law the three members of Committee due to retire shall retire, and three members shall be elected in accordance with the preceding by-law, and shall hold office until the close of the next but two succeeding annual general meetings.
- (d) At the fourth annual general meeting held after the coming into effect of this by-law and at each succeeding annual election the members elected shall hold office for three years.
