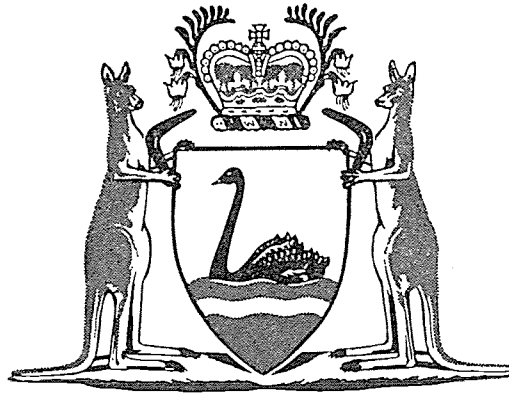

ORDER 1.

Authentication  
by Registrar  
of orders. 1. An order is sufficiently authenticated if signed by the Registrar of the  
Court sitting at Perth.

Authentication  
by Deputy  
Registrars of  
orders.

2. Without limiting the generality of the immediately preceding Rule, an  
order is sufficiently authenticated when made by the Court or a Judge sitting  
at Perth if signed by the Deputy Registrar of the Court sitting at Perth, and  
when made by the Court or a Judge sitting at a place outside of Perth, if  
signed by the Deputy Registrar of the Court sitting at that place.

Powers of

Court at Perth. 3. The Deputy Registrar of the Court sitting at Perth is empowered to  
do such things, to transact such business, and to exercise such jurisdiction  
as the Registrar of the Court appointed under section 25, sitting in chambers,
