BUSH FIRES ACT 1954-1981. Shire of Perenjori.

Notice to all Owners and/or Occupiers of Land in the Shire of Perenjori.

PURSUANT to the powers contained in section 33 of the above Act, you are hereby required on or before 15 October 1983, to remove from the land owned or occupied by you, all inflammable material or to clear firebreaks in accordance with the following, and thereafter to maintain the land of the firebreaks clear of inflammable material up to and including 31 March 1984:—

- (1) Townsite Land: In respect of the land owned or occupied by you within the townsite of Perenjori, Bowgada, Caron, Latham, Bunjil, or Maya you shall:—
 - (a) where the area of the land is 0.2 hectares (½ acre) or less, remove all inflammable material on the land from the whole of all land; and
 - (b) where the area of the land exceeds 0.2 hectares (½ acre) clear of all inflammable material, firebreaks at least 3 metres wide immediately inside all external surroundings boundaries of the land and also immediately surrounding all buildings situated on the land.
- (2) Rural Land: In respect of land owned or occupied by you other than within the townsites referred to in paragraph (1) above, you shall clear of all inflammable materials, firebreaks at least 3 metres wide.
 - (a) Immediately inside all external boundaries of the land and also immediately or group of buildings and/or haystack situated on the land; and
 - (b) not less than one chain and not more than five chains from the perimeter of all buildings and/or haystacks or groups of buildings and/or haystacks situated on the land; and

- (c) where the area of land exceeds 300 hectares you shall construct additional firebreaks not less than 3 metres wide in such positions as will divide the land into areas of not more than 300 hectares completely surrounded by a firebreak not less than 3 metres wide.
- (3) Fuel Dumps: In addition to the firebreaks required by paragraph (1) and (2) above you shall remove all inflammable material from all the land occupied by drums used for the storage of inflammable liquid, whether the drums contain inflammable material or not, including the land on which ramps for the holding the drums are constructed and to a distance of at least 3 metres outside the perimeter of any drums, stacks of drums, or drum ramp.

If it is considered to be impracticable for any reason to clear firebreaks or to remove inflammable material from the land as required by this notice you shall apply in writing to the Council or its duly authorised officer not later than 15 October 1983, for permission if considered necessary to provide firebreaks in alternative positions or to take alternative action to abate fire hazards on the land. If permission is not granted by the Council or its duly appointed officer, you shall comply with the requirements of this notice.





MADE by the Chairman of the Workers' Compensation Board.

Citation.

1. These rules may be cited as the Workers' Compensation Board Amendment Rules $1983\ (2)$.

Principal rules.

2. In these rules the Workers' Compensation Board Rules 1982^* are referred to as "the principal rules".

New rule 17.

- 3. The principal rules are amended by substituting for rule 17 a new rule as follows:—
 - 17. Where there is failure on the part of a party to proceedings—
 - (a) to comply with any of these rules;
 - (b) to comply with an interlocutory order; or
 - (c) to attend a preliminary hearing

the Registrar or Member shall note such matter on the file and may adjourn the Preliminary Hearing or refer the case to the Board and upon that reference the Board may order that the application be dismissed or that it be treated as undefended and on appropriate evidence make an award or make an order that the case be listed for hearing in the contested list or may make such other order as it considers appropriate. DAIRY INDUSTRY ACT 1973 (AS AMENDED).

Directions under section 30.

I, HYWEL DAVID EVANS, Minister for Agriculture, being the Minister for the time being administering the Dairy Industry Act 1973, as amended, acting under section 30 of that Act and after considering a statement submitted to me under subsection (1) of that section by the Dairy Industry Authority of Western Australia established under that Act (referred to in these directions as "the Authority") hereby direct the Authority that:

- 1. Where an application is made under paragraph (a) of subsection (4) of section 30 of the Act—
 - (a) the Authority shall refuse the application if approval of the application would result in the proposed transferee, or the proposed transferee together with any person associated with the proposed transferee (as determined by the Authority in accordance with clause 2 of this direction), holding a market milk quota or market quotas exceeding in the aggregate 1 100 litres on a daily basis, except where an entire market milk quota which is in excess of 1 100 litres daily is being transferred to a proposed transferee who has not previously held a market milk quota;
 - (b) subject to paragraph (a) of this clause, in the circumstances set out in section 30A (2) (a) of the Act, the Authority shall approve the transfer of market milk quota except where—
 - (i) the proposed transferor has received market milk quota within the preceding 3 years in accordance with the direction by the Minister under section 27 of the Act as a dairyman who had not previously held a market milk quota; or
 - (ii) the proposed transferee or the proposed transferor have received a market milk quota or the market milk quota respectively, during the preceding 3 years as a result of a transfer between members of the family of the applicant, being spouses, parents, or children of that family (referred to in these directions as a "family transfer"),

unless-

(iii) the circumstances are such that refusal of the application would in the opinion of the Authority cause undue hardship

- and the Authority is satisfied that approval of the application would not otherwise be inconsistent with these directions; and
- (c) subject to paragraph (a) of this clause, in the case of a family transfer where the application involves the transfer of the whole interest of the applicant in the market milk quota, the Authority may approve the transfer of the market milk quota except where—
 - (i) the proposed transferee has within 3 years of the date of the application held a market milk quota in accordance with a direction under section 27 of the Act as a dairyman who had not previously held a market milk quota; or
 - (ii) the proposed transferor had purchased the market milk quota within 3 years of the date of the application.
- 2. A person is associated with a proposed transferee if that person holds a market milk quota and is—
 - (a) a spouse of the proposed transferee;
 - (b) a partner of the proposed transferee;
 - (c) a corporation of which the proposed transferee is an officer or director;
 - (d) where the proposed transferee is a corporation an officer or director of the corporation;
 - (e) an officer or director of any corporation of which the proposed transferee is an officer or director;
 - (f) an employee or employer of the proposed transferee;
 - (g) an employee of a natural person of whom the proposed transferee is an employee;
 - (h) a corporation whose directors are accustomed or under an obligation whether formal or informal, to act in accordance with the directions, instructions or wishes of the proposed transferee or, where the person is a corporation, of the directors or management of that person;
 - (i) a corporation in accordance with the directions, instructions or wishes of which, or of the directors or management of which, the proposed transferee is accustomed or under an obligation, whether formal or informal, to act;
 - (j) a corporation in which the proposed transferee holds a substantial interest; or
 - (k) where that person is a corporation—a person who holds a substantial interest in the corporation.

but persons shall not be regarded as associates if the Authority is satisfied on representations made by one or more of them and after its own enquiries (if any) that they are commercially independent in their respective enterprises.

- 3. Where an application is made under paragraph (b) of subsection (4) of section 30 of the Act—
 - (a) the Authority shall refuse the application if the proposed surrender is subject to payment by the Authority of an amount of compensation exceeding \$100 per litre of market milk quota on a daily basis; and
- (b) the Authority shall refuse the application if the proposed surrender would result in the applicant retaining a market milk quota of less than 245 litres on a daily basis.
- 4. The bases or principles set out in the directions made under section 30 of the Act on 19 November 1982 and published in the *Government Gazette* on 26 November 1982 at pages 4653 and 4654 shall be of no further effect after 31 December 1983 whereupon these directions come into effect.
