ASSOCIATIONS INCORPORATION ACT 1895.

THE ASSOCIATIONS REGULATIONS 1953.

Published in the Government Gazette on 11 December 1953 and now reprinted, pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act 1954, incorporating the amendments thereto published on—

- 11 December 1959;
- 30 June 1978;
- 5 December 1980;
- 12 November 1982; and
- 28 October 1983.

Reprinted pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act 1954 by authority of the Attorney General dated 28 February 1984.

THE ASSOCIATIONS REGULATIONS 1953.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as The Associations Regulations 1953.
- 2. In these Regulations and in the forms in Schedule I to these Regulations—
 - (a) "the Act" means the Associations Incorporation Act 1895-19531;
 - (b) "Registrar" means the Registrar as defined in Section 2 of the Act:
 - (c) without affecting the generality of the term "document" includes notice, affidavit and memorial.

Preparation of Documents.

- 3. All documents prepared for filing with the Registrar shall-
 - (a) be accompanied when filed by the appropriate fee;
 - (b) be legibly and clearly written, typewritten or printed;
 - (c) be prepared on paper of medium weight and good quality and in a clean and unmutilated condition, and (with the exception of the Rules, Regulations or Constitution of an association) on paper of foolscap folio size;
 - (d) where the document comprises two or more sheets be secured together in a sufficient manner.
- 4. Except by special leave of the Registrar granted upon such conditions as he may think fit, a document which does not comply with regulation 3 of these regulations shall not be received by the Registrar.
- 5. The Registrar may require fresh copies of any document which is improperly filled in or which shows traces of erasures or which contains any alterations and the fresh copies shall be prepared and signed in the manner prescribed by the Act or by these regulations in respect of the original document. Every alteration made in any document or form shall be initialled by the person who signed the document or form in which the alteration has been made and by the witness, if any.

- 6. Where the Attorney General issues a certificate pursuant to section 2 or section 7A of the Act that certificate shall be filed with the Registrar with the memorial for incorporation or the notice of change of objects, as the case may be.
- 7. Where any document or part thereof required to be filed with the Registrar is not written in the English language that document or part, unless the Registrar otherwise directs, shall be accompanied by a translation thereof certified by the statutory declaration of a person approved by the Registrar.

Prescribed Forms.

- 8. The forms set out in Schedule I to these regulations, or forms to the like effect, shall be used for the purposes for which they are respectively appropriate and the particulars contained therein are hereby prescribed as the particulars required in the Act. The directions contained in any such form for the completion thereof shall be observed.
- 9. The forms prescribed by these regulations may be modified in a particular case by authority of the Registrar. Any document or form not provided for in these regulations may be provided for and any irregularity in procedure may be corrected in such form or manner as the Registrar may direct.

Prescribed Fees.

Amended by G.G. 30/6/78, to the Registrar for the several matters therein referred to.

- (1a) Notwithstanding subregulation (1) of this regulation and Schedule II to these regulations, no fee shall be payable to the Registrar by any person for the inspection of the memorial and the rules and regulations or Trust or Settlement deed of an Association as the case may be, prior to the incorporation of the Association under the provisions of the Act.
- (2) Any person or corporation furnishing to the Registrar any document required by the Act or these regulations without payment of the prescribed fee, and failing or neglecting to pay such fee forthwith after being called upon by the Registrar by notice in writing to do so shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding forty dollars.
