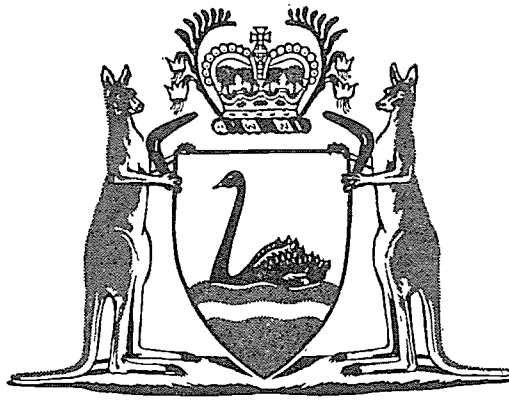

MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS ACT 1973.

MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS (SALES) REGULATIONS 1974.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicle Dealers (Sales) Regulations 1974. Citation.
2. In these regulations unless the contrary intention appears— Interpretation.
 "form" means a form in the First Schedule;
 "schedule" means a schedule to these regulations;
 "section" means a section of the Act;
 "the Act" means the Motor Vehicle Dealers Act 1973.
3. The register of transactions to be kept by a dealer pursuant to section 25 shall be kept in the form of a bound book the pages of which— Register of transactions (Form 1).
 (a) shall be in the form of Form 1; and
 (b) shall be numbered consecutively.
4. The particulars of acquisition or sale of a second-hand vehicle to be forwarded under section 26 to the licensing authority shall be in the form of Form 2 or Form 3 respectively. Notice of acquisition or sale of second-hand vehicle (Forms 2 and 3).
5. (1) The form of notice of required particulars to be displayed under subsection (1) of section 33 of the Act shall be in the form of Form 4. Notice of particulars to be displayed (Form 4).
 (2) The notice of required particulars prescribed by subregulation (1) of this regulation— Amended by G.G. 11/10/74, p. 3885; G.G. 21/12/79, p. 3988.
 (a) shall be printed on cerise coloured paper that is 190 mm long and 210 mm wide;
 (b) shall be printed in the type, size and manner to conform to Form 4; and
 (c) shall contain, in addition to the required particulars set out in subsection (3) of section 33, the following particulars—
 (i) the make, type and model designation of the vehicle;
 (ii) the engine number of the vehicle;
 (iii) the reference number of the vehicle in the dealer's register of transactions for the premises in which the vehicle is displayed; and shall make provision for the insertion of—
 (iv) the reading of the odometer of the vehicle at the time of the sale by the dealer who is offering it for sale;
 (v) the date of the sale by the dealer; and
 (vi) the signatures of the dealer and the purchaser.

- (3) When a sale of a second-hand vehicle occurs, the dealer shall enter in the notice of required particulars which was displayed on the vehicle at the time of the sale and all copies thereof—
 (a) the reading of the odometer of the vehicle at the time of the sale; and
 (b) the date of the sale,
 before he gives a copy thereof to the purchaser pursuant to subsection (7) of section 33.
6. (1) The form of notice for the purposes of subsection (1) of section 35 shall be in the form of Form 5. Notice of excluded defects (Form 5).
 (2) The notice prescribed by subregulation (1) of this regulation— Amended by G.G. 11/10/74, p. 3885.
 (a) shall be printed on orange paper that is not less than 170 mm long and 210 mm wide; and
 (b) shall be printed in the type, size and manner to conform to Form 5.

Sale of vehicle exempt from warranty (Form 6).

7. (1) A dealer shall not sell or expose for sale a second-hand vehicle of a type or class of second-hand vehicle in respect of which a notice has been published under subsection (5) of section 34 exempting a second-hand vehicle of that type or class of second-hand vehicle from the provisions of subsection (1) of section 34, unless a notice in the form of Form 6 is displayed thereon in accordance with this regulation.

(2) The notice prescribed in subregulation (1) of this regulation—

- (a) shall be affixed or attached directly to the inside of the lower windscreen of the second-hand vehicle in the case of a vehicle that is not a motor cycle or in the case of a motor cycle in a conspicuous place and shall face outwards when attached;
- (b) shall be printed in the type, size and manner to conform to Form 6;
- (c) shall be printed on white paper that is 125 mm long and 170 mm wide;
- (d) shall, when the vehicle is sold, be signed, together with a copy thereof, by the purchaser and by the dealer or a yard manager or salesman acting on his behalf.

(3) The copy of the prescribed notice referred to in paragraph (d) of subregulation (2) of this regulation, duly signed in accordance with that paragraph, shall be given to the buyer at the time of the sale.

Sales between trade owners (Form 7).

8. (1) When a sale of a second-hand vehicle takes place between trade owners, the seller shall complete in duplicate a trade owners disposal notice in the form of Form 7.

(2) The original of the notice prescribed by subregulation (1) of this regulation shall be supplied to the buyer and the duplicate thereof shall be retained by the seller.

Sale by non-trade owner to dealer (Form 7).

9. (1) When a person, other than a trade owner, sells a second-hand vehicle to a dealer the seller shall complete in duplicate a notice of sale in the form of Form 7.

(2) The original of the notice prescribed by subregulation (1) of this regulation shall be supplied to the dealer and the duplicate thereof shall be retained by the seller.

Notice prohibiting sale of second-hand vehicle (Form 9).

10. (1) The notice prohibiting the sale of a second-hand vehicle to be attached under subsection (1) of section 28 shall be in the form of Form 9.

(2) The notice prescribed by subregulation (1) of this regulation—

- (a) shall be printed on green paper that is not less than 130 mm long and 90 mm wide;
- (b) shall be attached directly to the driver's side of the front windscreen of the second-hand vehicle in the case of a vehicle that is not a motor cycle or in the case of a motor cycle shall be attached in a conspicuous position and shall face outwards when attached; and
- (c) shall be printed in the type, size and manner that conforms to Form 9.

Advertising.

11. (1) Every advertisement referring to a specified second-hand vehicle or to any specified second-hand vehicles shall clearly and accurately specify—

- (a) the registration number of the second-hand vehicle;
- (b) the year of manufacture;
- (c) the cash price; and
- (d) address of the registered premises of the dealer at which the vehicle is offered for sale.

(2) A dealer shall not advertise a second-hand vehicle or cause or permit a second-hand vehicle to be advertised unless the advertisement conforms to the provisions of subregulation (1) of this regulation.

Undesirable practices (Second Schedule).

12. The practices set out in the Second Schedule are undesirable practices for the purposes of section 41.

Prescribed accessories (Third Schedule).

13. The accessories set out in the Third Schedule are prescribed accessories for the purposes of paragraph (d) of subsection (3) of section 34.

Penalties.

14. A person who contravenes or fails to comply with the provisions of these regulations commits an offence and is liable to a penalty of \$200.

NOTICE PROHIBITING SALE OF SECOND-HAND VEHICLE.

At the time of inspection by a member of the Police Force, authorized officer or Traffic Inspector examining or testing second-hand vehicles, this vehicle required attention to comply with the law relating to the equipment, serviceability or roadworthiness of vehicles.

The sale of this vehicle is prohibited, except for the purposes of breaking up, unless and until this label has been removed by a member of the Police Force, authorized officer or Traffic Inspector.

2. Offering for sale by a person licensed under the Act of a second-hand vehicle other than a second-hand vehicle of which he or his employer is not the trade owner from a place that is not a registered premises under the Act.

3. Advertising or displaying a telephone number for the purpose of selling a vehicle the vendor of which is the trade owner or is employed by the trade owner except—
 - (a) a telephone number of a registered premises under the Act; and
 - (b) an “after-hours” telephone number that is advertised or displayed—
 - (i) at a registered premises;
 - (ii) on business cards or letterheads; or
 - (iii) in a telephone directory.
4. Offering for sale or the advertising of a second-hand vehicle for sale by a person who is not the owner or assignee of the second-hand vehicle.
