EDUCATION ACT 1928.

EDUCATION ACT AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No. 5) 1984.

MADE by the Minister for Education.

Citation
and
principal

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Education Act Amendment Regulations (No. 5) 1984.

(2) In these regulations the Education Act Regulations 1960* are referred to as the principal regulations.

2. Regulation 252D of the principal regulations is amended—

(a) in subregulation (2), by deleting "The" and substituting the following—

" Subject to subregulation (2a), the "; and

(b) by inserting after subregulation (2) the following subregulation—

" (2a) Upon the coming into operation of the Education Act Amendment Regulations (No. 5) 1984 the Board established pursuant to subregulation (1) shall consist of—

(a) a person not being an employee of the Education Department who shall be appointed by the Director General to be Chairman of the Board;

(b) 2 representatives of the Department nominated by the Director General;

(c) 2 representatives of the Union nominated by the Union; and

(d) 1 representative elected by the Advisory Committee established under regulation 256 in relation to the particular technical college, school or centre wherein the special position is to be filled. "

3. The principal regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 252E the following regulation—

“ 252F. Where a question requiring a vote arises at a meeting of the Board, the question shall be decided by a majority of the votes of the members of the Board present, and if there is an equality of votes on a question the Chairman is entitled to a casting vote in addition to a deliberative vote. ”.

Transitional.

4. (1) An appeal under regulation 252E (1) of the principal regulations in respect of an application considered by the former Board before the commencement day shall be dealt with under the principal regulations as in force after the commencement day.

(2) In this regulation—

“commencement day” means the day that the Education Act Amendment Regulations (No. 5) 1984 came into operation;

“former Board” means the Technical Appointments Board as constituted under regulation 252D (2) of the principal regulation as in force before the commencement day.
