Land Act 1933.

ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act 1933, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any Reserve shall vest in and be held by any person or persons to be named in the order in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order; and whereas it is deemed expedient as follows:—

Land Act 1933. ORDER IN COUNCIL.




