AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chambers, at Perth, this 28th day of January 1986, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

Water Authority Act 1984.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 86 (e) of the Water Authority Act 1984, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that works serving the aboriginal communities be declared exempt as per the following schedule.

Schedule.

Water Supply and Sewerage Works serving aboriginal communities where:

- (a) all the works are on land which is controlled by a legally incorporated aboriginal community or on the community's behalf by the Aboriginal Lands Trust;
- (b) the community has specifically requested the Water Authority to carry out works; and
- (c) the works are funded in total by the Commonwealth Department of Aboriginal Affairs.

Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by the Act, doth hereby exempt the works to aboriginal communities from the operation of section 86 (e) of the Water Authority Act 1984.



NAVIGABLE WATERS REGULATIONS.

Water Ski Areas.

Department of Marine and Harbours, Fremantle, 12 February 1986.

ACTING pursuant to the powers conferred by Regulation 48A of the Navigable Waters Regulations, the Department of Marine and Harbours by this Notice defines and sets aside the following area of navigable waters for water skiing and use by those members of the West Australian Water Ski Association and Albany Water Ski Club involved in a Ski Show, only between 0800 hours to 1430 hours Sunday 2 March 1986

A course depicted by buoys in Princess Royal Har-bour commencing at a point 100 metres south of Town Jetty, thence 350 metres southwest, thence 600 metres in a generally northwestern direction, thence 250 metres to the northeast thence to the starting point.

NAVIGABLE WATERS AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1986.

MADE by	His Exce	ellency the	Governor in	n Executive	Council.
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1. These regulations may be cited as the Navigable Waters Amendment Regu-Citation lations 1986.

2. In these regulations the Navigable Waters Regulations* are referred to as the principal regulations.

Principal regulations

Regulations 45A amended.

Regulations 45A of the principal regulations is amended in subregulation
 by inserting after the definition of "owner" the following definition—
 "registered interstate pleasure vessel" means a registrable vessel which is currently registered in any State or Territory under a system of regis-tration equivalent to that under this Part; ".

Regulation 45B amended.

- Regulation 45B of the principal regulations is amended— (a) in subregulation (1), by deleting "subregulation (2)" and substituting the following
 - subregulations (2) and (2a) and to regulation 45BAA
- (b) by inserting after subregulation (2) the following subregulation-
 - (2a) A person may, within the period of 3 months immediately succeeding the day of entry of a registered interstate pleasure vessel into any navigable waters, use or have in navigable waters a registered interstate pleasure vessel that is not registered with the department in accordance with this regulation.
- (c) in the Table to subregulation (3), by deleting "(iii) 10 metres or

 - (iv) 20 metres or over but less than 30 metres76
 - (v) 30 metres or over but less than 40 metres152
- "; (vi) 40 metres or over......304 (d) in subregulation (6), by inserting after "Part," the following-
 - " other than under regulation 45BAA, ";
- (e) in subregulation (7), by inserting after "registrable vessel" the following
 - other than a foreign pleasure vessel as defined in regulation 45BAA(1), ": and
- (f) in subregulation (8), by inserting after "registrable vessel" the following
 - other than a foreign pleasure vessel as defined in regulation 5BAA(1)45BAA(1),

Regulation 45BAA inserted.

- After regulation 45B of the principal regulations the following heading and regulation are inserted-
 - Registration of Foreign Pleasure Vessels.
 - 45BAA. (1) In this regulation-
 - "foreign pleasure vessel" means a registrable vessel which is owned by a person who is not a permanent resident of the State and which is temporarily within navigable waters but does not include a registered interstate pleasure vessel;
 - "proposed departure date" in relation to a foreign pleasure vessel means the date notified to the department pursuant to subregulation (4) (g) in respect of that vessel.

(2) Subject to subregulation (3), a person shall not use or have in any navigable waters a foreign pleasure vessel unless the vessel is registered with the department in accordance with this regulation.

(3) A person may, within the period of 30 days immediately succeeding the day of entry of the foreign pleasure vessel into any navigable waters, use or have in navigable waters a foreign pleasure vessel that is not registered with the department in accordance with this regulation.

(4) Every application for the registration of a foreign pleasure vessel shall be made to the department in writing on a form specified by the Minister and shall include particulars of-

- (a) the full name and residential address of the owner of the vessel and the telephone number of any telephone installed at that address for the owner:
- the full name and residential address of the master of the vessel; (b) the overall length of the vessel expressed in metres expressed to 2 (c)
- decimal places;
- the type of construction of the vessel and its colour; (d)
- the power in kilowatts and name of the manufacturer of the engine fitted to the vessel or carried as an auxiliary in the vessel and a (e) statement as to whether the engine is of the inboard or outboard type
- (f) the date of entry of the vessel into navigable waters; and

(g) the proposed date of departure of the vessel from navigable waters, and the application shall be accompanied by a recording fee of \$7.50 and the appropriate fee ascertained in accordance with the following table for each three month period or part of a three-month period for which it is proposed the vessel will be in navigable waters-

(5) When the department registers a foreign pleasure vessel under this regulation the department shall, if the vessel has not previously been registered under this regulation, allot a registration number for the vessel and issue to the owner for whom the application was made

- (a) an identification card, which identification card shall include the registration number allotted by the department for the vessel at the time when the vessel was first registered under this regulation; and
- a certificate of registration for the vessel, which certificate shall in-(b) dicate the date of expiry of the registration of the vessel.

(6) A person shall not use or have in any navigable waters a foreign pleasure vessel unless both the identification card and the certificate of registration referred to in subregulation (5) are carried upon the vessel and displayed when required for identification of the vessel.

(7) Where an application for registration as a foreign pleasure vessel is duly made under this regulation and is accompanied by the prescribed fees the department shall issue a certificate of registration for a period commencing on the date shown on the receipt imprinted on the certificate and expiring on the proposed departure date.

(8) Where a foreign pleasure vessel previously registered under this regulation does not leave navigable waters on the proposed departure date and application for registration of the vessel under this regulation is duly made under subregulation (4) and is accompanied by the prescribed fee before that registration expires or within 30 days immediately succeeding the day on which that registration expires the department shall register the vessel for a period expiring on the proposed departure date shown in that application and the registration shall be deemed to be a continuation of the previous registration and to have effect on and from the day next succeeding the day on which that registration expires.




