UNDER section 10 (2) of the Shipping and Pilotage Act 1967, I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare the boundaries of the port of Perth described in the Schedule to that Act and varied by proclamation made on 20 May 1986 and published in the *Gazette* on 13 June 1986 to be varied by the addition of the waters described in the Schedule to this proclamation.

#### Schedule

1. All that portion of water of Thomson Bay, Rottnest Island bounded by lines running 114° from Mushroom Rock to Phillip Rock lighthouse and then 142° to Phillip Point starboard beacon and then 252° to the eastern tip of Phillip Point.
2. All that portion of water known as Hillarys Boat Harbour bounded by lines starting at the high water mark of the Indian Ocean and the northern breakwater at a point in latitude 31° 49' 17.6" S, longitude 115° 44' 08.9" E, and extending in a generally south-westerly direction to a point bearing 271° 54' about 12 m from the northern breakwater light in latitude 31° 49' 29.4" S, longitude 115° 43' 55.7" E; thence 271° 54' about 135 m to the high water mark on the southern breakwater at a point bearing 271° 54',

about 12 m from the southern breakwater light in latitude 31° 49' 29.25" S, longitude 115° 43' 50.5" E; thence in a generally southeasterly direction along the high water mark of the southern breakwater about 1 120 m to the shore; thence in a generally north-westerly direction along the high water mark to the starting point.

3. All that portion of water known as Challenger Harbour bounded by lines starting at the high water mark of the Indian Ocean and the northern breakwater at a point in latitude 32° 03' 39.5" S, longitude 115° 44' 21.8" E and extending in a generally southwesterly, southerly, and southeasterly direction to a point bearing 76° 34' and 12 m distant from the breakwater light tower in latitude 32° 03' 52.9" S, longitude 115° 44' 17.2" E; thence bearing 76° 34', 75 m to the South Cardinal Entrance beacon in latitude 32° 03' 52.3" S, longitude 115° 44' 20.4" E; thence bearing 16° 0', 22 m to the high water mark adjoining the southern breakwater; thence in a generally northwesterly, northeasterly, southeasterly, northeasterly and finally northwesterly direction around the high water mark to the starting point.

VALUATION OF LAND ACT 1978  
VALUATION DISTRICTS ORDER 1987

MADE by the Valuer General under section 17.

**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the *Valuation Districts Order 1987*.

**Definitions**

2. For the purposes of this Order—
  - (a) the terms "district", "municipality", and "ward" have the meanings assigned to them by section 6 of the *Local Government Act 1960*; and
  - (b) a district and a ward also include land, whether covered by water or not and although not otherwise within the boundaries of the district or ward, upon which is situate a jetty the approach to which is in the district or ward.

**Application of Interpretation Act 1984**

3. The *Interpretation Act 1984* applies to this Order as it applies to subsidiary legislation within the meaning of that Act.

**Reconstitution of valuation districts**

4. The State is reconstituted into valuation districts as set out in the Schedule, and accordingly the notice published in the *Government Gazette* on 30 March 1979 at page 849 under section 17 of the Act is revoked.

Schedule

1. For the purpose of determining unimproved values—
  - (a) every ward of the district of the municipality of the City of Perth;
  - (b) the district of every municipality, other than the City of Perth;
  - (c) every area of land, whether within the metropolitan region or not, that is subject to a separate or special rate under the *Local Government Act 1960*, notwithstanding that the land is contained within the area of a ward or district of a municipality;
  - (d) every townsite outside the metropolitan region that is constituted, defined or reserved as a townsite under the *Land Act 1933*, or any Act repealed thereby; and
  - (e) every area of land outside the metropolitan region that is declared a townsite under section 686 of the *Local Government Act 1960*,

shall constitute a separate valuation district.

2. For the purpose of determining gross rental values every area of land declared to be a rating or taxing area by a rating or taxing authority under a rating or taxing Act shall constitute a separate valuation district.

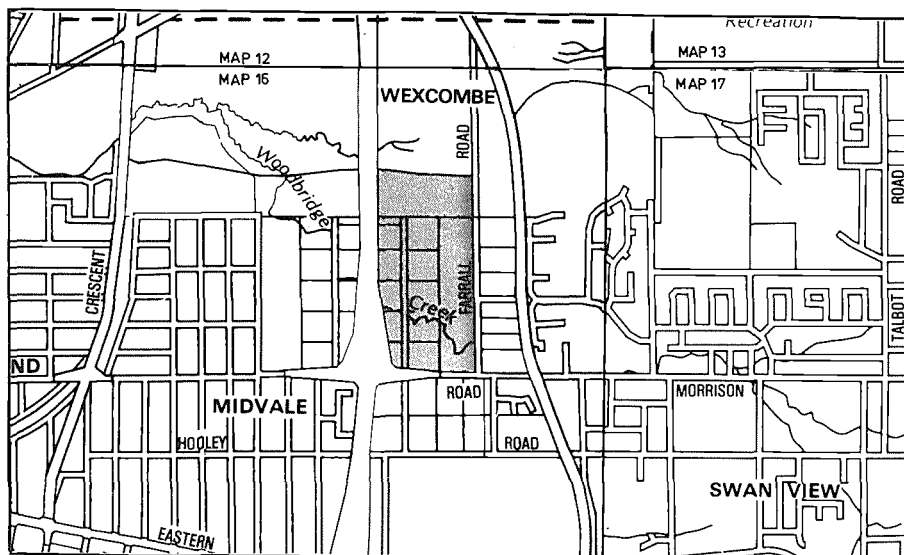

## Report of the Auditor

1. The financial statements of the Shire of Wyalkatchem are prepared on the basis of historical cost. In preparing its balance sheet it is not the policy of the Council to:—

- charge depreciation to write off the cost of each fixed asset over its estimated useful life; and
- recognise all assets and liabilities which exist at balance date.

2. The policy at (a) complies with the requirements of the Local Government Act and the Accounting Directions, although it is not in accordance with generally accepted accounting standards.

3. The policy at (b) does not comply with the Local Government Act, which requires an annual statement showing the assets and liabilities of the Council, nor does it comply with generally accepted accounting standards.

4. Council has spent approximately \$12 000 for which no budget item was raised in the 1985/86 budget. Such expenditure is unauthorised expenditure in accordance with the Local Government Act.

5. The Local Government Accounting Directions 1985 require Council to prepare financial statements on the accrual basis of accounting. At 30 June 1986, with the exception referred to in paragraph 1 (b), the financial statements complied with these requirements, although throughout the year ended on that date there were minor inconsistencies with those requirements, and, in my opinion, the surplus of \$54 536.96 at 1st July, 1985 on schedule 2 is incorrect. Net liabilities at 30 June 1985 of \$14 414.81 which in my opinion should have been recognised through schedule 2, have been recognised as adjustments through Schedule 1.

6. I have, with the assistance of my staff, audited the books of the Shire of Wyalkatchem for the year ended 30 June 1986. In my opinion, the financial statements, comprising schedules 1 to 16, and 20 to 25 are in agreement with the books and records of the Council, and, subject to my comments in paragraphs 3 to 5 are prepared on a basis consistent with the Local Government Act and the Accounting Directions.

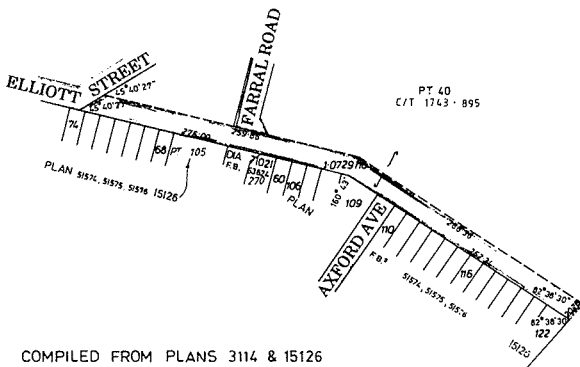

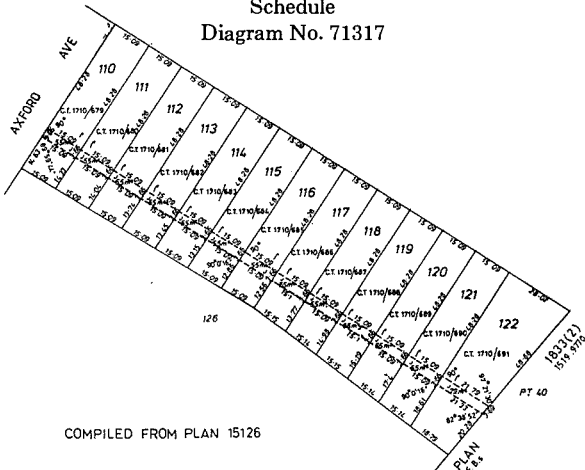

(b) Failure to pay the Charge upon making application for Relevant Enrolment shall render a person ineligible to attend the College and to pursue or gain credit in any course conducted by the College.

- (c) The Charge imposed by the College pursuant to the provisions of this statute shall not exceed the amount of Charge for a Relevant Enrolment calculated in accordance with the provisions of the States Grants (Tertiary Education Assistance) Act 1984 (as amended).

8. The Academic Registrar shall maintain a register of the use of the Graduation Seal in which shall be recorded, in respect of each certificate of an award to which the seal is affixed, particulars of the certificate, its date, the authority for it and the name and title of the persons signing and countersigning the document as required by section 6 of this Statute.

9. The Council may determine by resolution from time to time either generally or in any particular case or cases that in relation to any certificate of an award to which the Graduation Seal is affixed, the signature of the Director or the other person appointed by the Council to countersign the affixing of the Graduation Seal or both may be affixed by some mechanical means and be a facsimile of those persons' signatures in such manner as may be specified in the Council's resolution.

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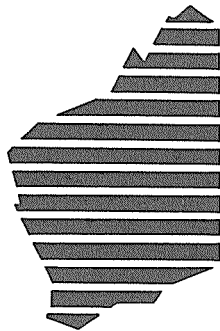
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
