#### Local Government Act 1960

##### ORDERS IN COUNCIL

WHEREAS by section 288 of the Local Government Act 1960, it shall be lawful for the Governor on request by a Council of a Municipal District, by Order published in the *Government Gazette* to declare any lands reserved or acquired for use by the public or used by the public as a street, way, public place, bridge or thoroughfare under the care, control, and management of the Council, or lands comprised in a private street, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of the Council, or lands comprised in a private street of which the public has had uninterrupted use for a period of not less than 10 years, as a public street and if the Council thinks fit, that the Governor shall declare the width of carriageway and footpaths of the public street; and whereas the Councils mentioned in the schedule hereto have requested that certain lands named and described in the said schedule, which have been reserved for streets within the said Councils, be declared public streets: Now therefore, the Lieutenant-Governor and Deputy of the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare the said lands to be public streets and such land shall, from the date of this Order, be absolutely dedicated to the public as streets within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.

5. Shall be registered as an export establishment pursuant to the provisions of the Parliament of the Commonwealth Export Control Act 1982, and Orders made thereunder, more specifically the Prescribed Goods (General) Orders and the Fish Orders, should it be used to process fish for export.
6. Shall not be used for the processing of marron (*Cherax tenuimanus*) unless a licence is held under section 39C of the Fisheries Act 1905.

In accordance with the provisions of section 35K, any person aggrieved by this decision may, within fourteen days after publication of this notice, appeal against the decision or order by serving on the Minister for Fisheries a statement in writing on the grounds of their appeal.

## APPLICATION FOR LEASING

APPLICATIONS are invited under section 117 of the Land Act 1933 for the leasing of the Seabird lots shown in the schedule for "Residential Purposes Associated with the Fishing Industry" for a term of ten (10) years at the annual rentals shown in the schedule.

Intending applicants shall submit with their applications, details of intended utilisation and proposed development indicating size and type of intended structures, cost estimates, source of funds and programme for construction whether staged or not.

The Minister for Lands reserves the right to refuse any application on the grounds that the proposed utilisation, development and/or development programme is inadequate or unsuitable or that the applicant has failed to show adequate capacity to fund the development.

The Services provided to the lots are bitumen kerbed roads and water and the ingoing premiums as shown in the schedule are payable within thirty (30) days of acceptance of application. Power is available under the Overhead Residential Distribution Scheme and will be connected upon application, and payment of the usual fees to the State Energy Commission.

Where the in-going lessee indicates that he anticipates a requirement for freehold during the currency of the lease, the Hon. Minister shall signify the extent of development (which may be additional to that required as the basis for leasing the site) that will be necessary to enable the issue of a Crown Grant.

Subject to agreement between the lessee and the Minister, the foregoing development obligations and other conditions set out herein may be varied or added to from time to time.

At any time during the currency of the lease, subject to the development obligations and other conditions having been met to the satisfaction of the Hon. Minister, the lessee may surrender his lease to the intent that he may apply for purchase of the said land. In this event a purchase price in accordance with the schedule shall apply for a period of 3 years from the date of approval of the lease (following which period the price shall be subject to review) and fees associated with the issue of a Crown Grant shall be payable.

The land is made available for leasing subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The land shall not be used for any purpose other than "Fisherman Residential" without the prior approval in writing of the Minister for Lands.
- (2) The rent shall be subject to reappraisal at the end of the third year of the term of the lease and each successive 3 yearly period thereafter.
- (3) The lessee shall not without the previous consent in writing of the Minister assign, transfer, mortgage sublet or part with the possession of the demised land.
- (4) The lessee shall commence construction within nine (9) months and thereafter continue construction and complete and operate the works within two (2) years from the date of the commencement of the lease.
- (5) All buildings, erections, paving, drainage and other works shall be to the approval of the Local Government and the lessee shall perform, discharge and execute all requisitions and works unto the demised land as are or may be required by any local or public authority operating under any statute by-law or regulation.
- (6) The lessee shall indemnify the Minister against all claims for damage to property or persons arising from the use of the land.
- (7) The Minister or his representative may enter the land for inspection at any reasonable time.
- (8) The land shall be filled to levels specified by, and acceptable to the Minister or his nominee and the Shire Council.
- (9) Compensation shall not be payable to the lessee in respect of any improvements effected by him on the demised land and remaining thereon at the expiration or earlier determination of the lease.
- (10) It shall be lawful for the lessee at any time within the three calendar months immediately following the expiration of the term or earlier determination

of the lease, to take down, remove and carry away any buildings, structures, improvements and plant the property of the lessee.

- (11) On determination of the lease, the lessee shall fill in, consolidate and level off any unevenness, excavation or hole caused by him during the term of the lease or by removal of his improvements and shall leave the demised land in a clean, neat and tidy condition to the satisfaction of the Minister and shall remove any or all waste matter as required by the Minister.
- (12) The lessee shall be a bona fide fisherman and be the holder of a current Professional Fisherman's Licence and should this condition not be satisfied, the lease may be forfeited.
- (13) A limit of one lot per person shall apply and for the purpose of this condition, husband and wife shall be deemed to be one.

A person in the employ of the State must apply through the Executive Director, Department of Land Administration for the Governor's permission to hold this land. Written approval of the Permanent Head concerned should accompany such application.

## TRAVEL AGENTS AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No. 2) 1987

MADE by the Lieutenant-Governor and Deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

**Citation**

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Travel Agents Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 1987*.

**Principal regulations**

2. In these regulations the *Travel Agents Regulations 1986\** are referred to as the principal regulations.

**Regulations 7 and 8 repealed and regulations 7, 8 and 8A substituted**

3. Regulations 7 and 8 of the principal regulations are repealed and the following regulations are substituted—

**Particulars prescribed in section 9 (3) (f)**

- “ 7. For the purposes of section 9 (3) (f) the applicant shall specify—
- (a) whether or not the applicant proposes to be personally present and in charge of the day to day conduct of business at a place specified by the applicant under section 9 (3) (b); and
  - (b) the qualifications of any person the applicant proposes to employ under section 29.

**Prescribed qualifications in sections 12 (2) (e) and 29**

8. (1) For the purposes of these regulations a person carrying on a business described in column 2 of the Table to this regulation carries on a business as a travel agent of a category described in column 1 of that Table.

(2) The qualifications prescribed for—

- (a) the purposes of section 29 (1) or (2); and
- (b) an individual referred to in section 12 (2) (e) who specifies in his application that he proposes to be personally present and in charge of the day to day conduct of business at a place specified by him in that application,

are the qualifications described in column 3 of the Table to this regulation opposite the category of business carried on, or proposed to be carried on, at the relevant place of business.

(3) A person who is entitled to carry on, or to conduct under section 29—

- (a) Category 1 business may do so in relation to Category 2, 3 and 4 business;
- (b) Category 2 business may do so in relation to Category 3 and 4 business; and
- (c) Category 3 business may do so in relation to Category 4 business.

(4) For the purposes of this regulation—

“selling tickets” means—

- (a) selling, offering for sale or advertising that the person will sell or offer to sell a ticket entitling another person to travel;
- (b) arranging, offering to arrange or advertising that the person will arrange or offer to arrange for another person a right of passage.

**Citation**

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Securities Industry (Application of Laws) Regulations 1987*.

**Commencement**

2. These regulations come into operation on the day on which Part II of the *Australian Stock Exchange and National Guarantee Fund Act 1987* of the Commonwealth comes into operation.

**Definition**

3. In these regulations, "the Act" means the *Securities Industry (Application of Laws) Act 1981*.

**Amendment of Schedule 1 to the Act**

shall be deemed to have been registered at the relevant commencement under section 45 of the *Companies (Western Australia) Code* in respect of—

- (f) The Stock Exchange of Adelaide Limited;
- (g) The Brisbane Stock Exchange Limited;
- (h) The Hobart Stock Exchange Limited;
- (i) The Stock Exchange of Melbourne Limited; and
- (j) The Sydney Stock Exchange Limited,

respectively.

(6) The registration, under Division 2 of Part III of the *Companies (Western Australia) Code* of each of the names referred to in subsection (5) paragraphs (f) to (j), inclusive, shall be deemed to have been cancelled at the relevant commencement under that Division.

(7) This section has effect notwithstanding anything in Division 2 of Part III of the *Companies (Western Australia) Code*, but nothing in this section prevents the cancellation, in accordance with that Division, of the registration of a name.

**Functions and powers under laws of the State**

36D. The Exchange shall perform the functions, and may exercise the powers, that are conferred, or expressed to be conferred, on it by or under an Act or by or under a regulation or other instrument made under, or by virtue of, an Act.

**Listing rules and business rules of the Exchange**

36E. 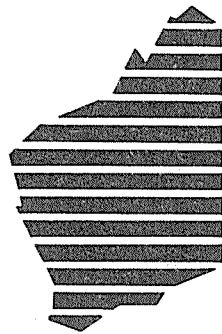
