FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1987

MADE by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Financial Administration Amendment Regulations 1987*.

Commencement

2. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 July 1987.

Regulation 24 inserted

3. After regulation 23 of the *Financial Administration Regulations 1986**, the following regulation is inserted—

Departments of Parliament

“ 24. The administration of—

- (a) the Legislative Assembly;
- (b) the Legislative Council;
- (c) the Joint House Committee;
- (d) the Joint Printing Committee; and
- (e) the Joint Library Committee,

is in each case deemed to constitute a department for the purposes of the Act. ”.

LIQUOR LICENSING (MORATORIUM) ACT 1983
LIQUOR LICENSING (MORATORIUM) ORDER 1987

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the *Liquor Licensing (Moratorium) Order 1987*.

Commencement

2. This Order shall take effect on the day that it is published in the *Government Gazette*.

Specified day

3. Pursuant to and for the purposes of the *Liquor Licensing (Moratorium) Act 1983*, in relation to licences of a kind listed in the Schedule, 31 December 1987 shall be the day specified as the day until which the Act shall have effect.

VALUATION OF LAND ACT 1978
VALUATION OF LAND AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1987

MADE by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Valuation of Land Amendment Regulations 1987*.

Commencement

2. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 July 1987.

Principal regulations

3. In these regulations the *Valuation of Land Regulations 1979** are referred to as the principal regulations.

Regulation 5 amended

4. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is amended by repealing subregulation (1) and substituting the following subregulation—

- “ (1) Subject to this regulation, the charges to be paid by a rating or taxing authority in respect of the matters referred to in section 38 of the Act shall be determined as follows—
