WATER AUTHORITY ACT 1984 LAND DRAINAGE AMENDMENT BY-LAWS 1988

Citation

1. These by-laws may be cited as the Water Authority (Charges) Amendment By-laws (No. 2) 1988.

Application

2. Nothing in these by-laws affects the application after the day of the coming into operation of these by-laws of a by-law in force before that day insofar as that by-law relates to a charge for a period commencing before that day.

WATER AUTHORITY OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA LAND DRAINAGE RATES FOR 1988/89

Albany, Busselton, Harvey, Mundijong, Roelands and Waroona Drainage Districts

THE Water Authority of Western Australia has resolved that the following rates shall apply to all rateable land within the Albany, Busselton, Harvey, Mundijong, Roelands and Waroona Drainage Districts for the rating year ending 30 June 1989—

Direct grade land—\$4.32 per hectare General grade land—86 cents per hectare

subject to the following minimum rates-

Rural land (as prescribed by the Land Drainage By-laws)

Urban land—general grade-

LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1925 LAND DRAINAGE NOTICE 1988

MADE by the Minister for Water Resources under section 90A of the Land Drainage Act 1925.

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Land Drainage Notice 1988.

Notice

- 2. For the purposes of section 88 (3) of the Act the maximum amount of the rates to be paid for the 1988/89 year in respect of land for which— $\,$
 - (a) the grading has not been amended since the 1987/88 year; and
 - (b) the area has not altered since the 1987/88 year,

shall be an amount that does not exceed the amount of rates paid in respect of that land in the 1987/88 year.

PETROLEUM PRODUCTS PRICING (MAXIMUM PRICES FOR MOTOR FUEL) AMENDMENT ORDER (No. 4) 1988

Commencement
