ELECTION OF SENATORS ACT 1903 PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA FRANCIS BURT, Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, By His Excellency the Honourable Sir Francis
Theodore Page Burt, Companion of the Order of
Australia, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint
George, Queen's Counsel, Lieutenant-Governor
and Administrator of the State of Western Australia.

I, the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, acting under the Election of Senators Act 1903 with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby, in relation to the election of 6 senators for the State of Western Australia, fix—

- (a) 26 February 1990 to be the date for the close of the rolls;
- (b) 2 March 1990, at 12 noon, to be the date and time before which nominations for the election are to be made;
- (c) 24 March 1990 to be the date of the polling; and
- (d) 30 May 1990 to be the date for the return of the Writ issued in respect of the election.

Given under my hand and the Seal of the State on the nineteenth day of February 1990.
