CONSTITUTION ACTS AMENDMENT ACT 1899.

It is hereby notified for public information that the following amendments should be made to the lists of Departments, Authorities, Statutes and Votes as published in the Special *Government Gazette* No. 26 of 1991 of 21 February 1991, to take into account changes approved by His Excellency the Governor on 27 February 1991:

- (i) The portfolio of "Sport and Recreation" should be deleted from the portfolio of the Minister for Mines; Fisheries; Sport and Recreation; Mid-West; Minister assisting the Minister for State Development.
- (ii) The portfolio of "Sport and Recreation" should be added to another portfolio now to be known as the Minister for Police; Emergency Services; Sport and Recreation.
