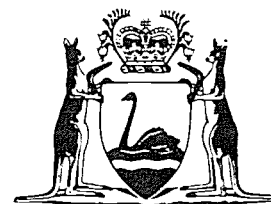

CONSUMER AFFAIRS ACT 1971-1983

Order

Schedule 1

Goods consisting of lensless racquet sport eye guards.

Schedule 2

The goods detailed in Schedule 1 shall—

(a) carry a warning label attached to the product with the words in red print stating—

"This product may not provide full protection in sport involving small high speed projectiles e.g. Squash."
