TOBACCO CONTROL ACT 1990

TOBACCO CONTROL (EXEMPTION) NOTICE 1992

Made by the Minister for Health under section 14 after consultation with the Minister for Sport and Recreation.

Citation

1. This notice may be cited as the *Tobacco Control (Exemption) Notice 1992*.

Exemption

2. (1) Subject to the conditions set out in clause 3, the Western Australian Cricket Association (Incorporated) and its agents and servants and all persons entitled to the use in Western Australia of Benson and Hedges trademarks and brand names and their agents and servants are exempted from the operation of sections 5 and 8 of the *Tobacco Control Act 1990* during the period ending on 30 April 1992 in respect of signs or objects (not being itinerary cards referred to in subclause (2)) —

- (a) publicly displayed at the Western Australian Cricket Association ground at Nelson Crescent, East Perth ("the WACA ground") during cricket test matches, World Series Cricket matches, Sheffield Shield cricket matches and World Cup cricket matches held at the WACA ground; and
- (b) promoting, bearing or containing Benson and Hedges trademarks or brand names.

(2) All persons are exempted from the operation of sections 5 and 8 of the *Tobacco Control Act 1990* during the period ending on 30 April 1992 in respect of itinerary cards promoting, bearing or containing —

- (a) Benson and Hedges trademarks or brand names; and
- (b) details of cricket fixtures in Australia during the 1991/1992 cricket season.

Conditions

3. The conditions subject to which the exemption referred to in clause 2 (1) is granted are that —

- (a) signs and objects shall be limited to —
 - (i) 4 perimeter signs, each not exceeding 22.496 metres in length by 0.914 metres in height;
 - (ii) one scoreboard sign not exceeding 10 metres in length by one metre in height;
 - (iii) one sign (not being a perimeter sign or a scoreboard sign) not exceeding 6 metres in length by 6 metres in height;
 - (iv) one drinks trolley bearing Benson and Hedges trademarks or brand names;
 - (v) any number of flags bearing Benson and Hedges trademarks or brand names; and
 - (vi) in the case only of World Cup cricket matches, 2 on-grass signs, each not exceeding 6 metres by 6 metres in area;

- (b) each sign or object (except a flag or an on-grass sign) shall display the health warning —
 - (i) "SMOKING CAUSES LUNG CANCER"; or
 - (ii) "SMOKING CAUSES HEART DISEASE",
 together with the statement "Health Authority Warning";
- (c) the area exclusively devoted to the display of a health warning and the statement "Health Authority Warning" on each sign or object referred to in paragraph (b) shall be not less than 25% of the area of that sign or object devoted to the display of the Benson and Hedges trademark or brand name;
- (d) in each sign or object referred to in paragraph (b) the health warning shall —
 - (i) appear directly beneath the Benson and Hedges trademark or brand name and directly adjacent to the statement "Health Authority Warning";
 - (ii) appear in white Helvetica Bold capitals on a black background; and
 - (iii) occupy, together with the statement "Health Authority Warning", not less than 80% of the area exclusively devoted to its display and that of that statement;
- (e) in each sign or object referred to in paragraph (b) the letters of the statement "Health Authority Warning" shall —
 - (i) appear in Helvetica Medium capitals and Helvetica Medium lower case type; and
 - (ii) not exceed half the height of the letters used for the health warning referred to in that paragraph;
 and
- (f) all signs and objects (including flags and on-grass signs) shall be removed from public display by 30 April 1992.
