SOIL AND LAND CONSERVATION ACT 1945

SOIL AND LAND CONSERVATION AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1992

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Soil and Land Conservation Amendment Regulations 1992.

Commencement

2. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 May 1992.

Principal regulations

- 3. In these regulations the Soil and Land Conservation Regulations 1984* are referred to as the principal regulations.
 - [* Published in the Gazette of 15 June 1984 at p.1651. For amendments to 20 March 1992 see 1990 Index to Legislation of Western Australia, p.366 and Gazettes of 3 May, 4 October and 29 November 1991.]

Regulation 5 repealed and a regulation substituted

4. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is repealed and the following regulation is substituted —

Notice of intention to drain or pump water

- "
 5. (1) When an owner or occupier of land proposes to drain or pump water from under the land surface because of the salinity of the land or the water and to discharge that water onto other land, into other water or into a watercourse, the owner or occupier shall, at least 90 days before the draining or pumping commences, notify the Commissioner in writing in the manner set forth in Form 1 in Schedule 4.
 - (2) An owner or occupier of land who gives notice to the Commissioner in accordance with subregulation (1) but fails to commence draining or pumping water within the period of 2 years from the date of the notice, is required, at least 90 days before he or she proposes to drain or pump water, to give notice, in accordance with subregulation (1), to the Commissioner for reassessment.
 - (3) An owner or occupier who discharges water without having notified the Commissioner in accordance with subregulations (1) or (2) commits an offence.

Penalty: \$2 000.

(4) On receiving a notice under subregulation (1), the Commissioner shall send a copy of the notice to any Public Authority or district committee that is or may be concerned with the salinity of that other land or water.

Regulation 6 inserted

5. After regulation 5 of the principal regulations the following regulation is inserted —

Notice of intention to drain or pump water in the Peel-Harvey Catchment Area

- 6. (1) When an owner or occupier of land situated in the area set out in Figure 1 of Appendix 1 to the Statement of Planning Policy No. 2* known as the Peel-Harvey Catchment Area proposes to drain or pump water from, on or under the land and to discharge that water onto other land, into other water or into a watercourse, whether within the area or outside the area, the owner or occupier shall, at least 90 days before draining or pumping commences, notify the Commissioner in writing in the manner set forth in Form 2 in Schedule 4.
- (2) An owner or occupier of land who gives notice to the Commissioner in accordance with subregulation (1) but fails to commence draining or pumping water within the period of 2 years from the date of the notice, is required, at least 90 days before he or she proposes to drain or pump water, to give notice, in accordance with subregulation (1), to the Commissioner for reassessment.
- (3) An owner or occupier who discharges water without having notified the Commissioner in accordance with subregulations (1) or (2) commits an offence.

Penalty: \$2 000.

- (4) On receiving a notice under subregulation (1), the Commissioner shall send a copy of the notice to any Public Authority or district committee that is or may be concerned with the condition of that other land or water.

TOBACCO CONTROL ACT 1990

TOBACCO CONTROL (EXEMPTION) NOTICE (NO. 9) 1992

Made by the Minister for Health under section 14 after consultation with the Minister for Sport and Recreation.

Citation

This notice may be cited as the Tobacco Control (Exemption) Notice (No. 9) 1992.

Exemption

2. Subject to the conditions set out in clause 3, the body known as the New South Wales Rugby League Limited and its agents and servants are exempted from the operation of sections 5 and 8 of the Tobacco Control Act 1990 in respect of the New South Wales Rugby League Winfield Cup match ("the Match") to be held in Perth on Friday 8 May 1992 at the Western Australian Cricket Association Ground ("the WACA") between Canterbury-Bankstown and Parramatta.

Conditions

- 3. The conditions subject to which the exemption referred to in clause 2 is granted are that
 - (a) any trademark or brand name of a tobacco product shall be displayed only
 - (i) on 2 A frame signs measuring 7 metres by 1 metre situated at the WACA; or
 - (ii) when incidentally or accidentally present in photographs used to publicize the Match.
 - (b) any trademark or brand name of a tobacco product, or any tobacco advertisement, shall be accompanied by the health warning
 - (i) "SMOKING CAUSES LUNG CANCER"; or
 - (ii) "SMOKING CAUSES LUNG DISEASE",

together with the statement "Health Authority Warning";

- (c) the area exclusively devoted to the display of the health warning referred to in paragraph (b) and the statement "Health Authority Warning" shall be not less than 25% of the area devoted to the display of the trademark or brand name or tobacco advertisement referred to in that paragraph;
- (d) the health warning referred to in paragraph (b) shall
 - (i) appear directly beneath the trademark or brand name or tobacco advertisement referred to in that paragraph and directly adjacent to the statement "Health Authority Warning";
 - (ii) appear in white Helvetica Bold capitals on a black background; and
 - (iii) occupy, together with the statement "Health Authority Warning", not less than 80% of the area devoted to the display of that health warning and that statement;

and

- (e) the letters of the statement "Health Authority Warning" shall
 - (i) appear in Helvetica Medium capitals and Helvetica Medium lower case type; and
 - (ii) not exceed half the height of the letters used for the health warning referred to in paragraph (b).
