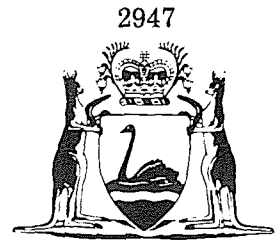

ADMINISTRATION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE STATE

Notice is hereby given that, His Excellency the Governor being on leave and not having appointed a deputy under clause XVI of the Letters Patent dated 14 February 1986 constituting the office of Governor of the State of Western Australia and providing for persons appointed to administer the government of the State, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor the Honourable David Kingsley Malcolm A.C. issued the following proclamation—

1. The Honourable Sir Francis Theodore Page Burt, Companion of the Order of Australia, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Queen's Counsel, Governor of the State of Western Australia, is on leave and has not appointed a deputy under clause XVI of the Letters Patent dated 14 February 1986 constituting the office of Governor of the State of Western Australia and providing for persons appointed to administer the government of the State.
2. Under clause XI of those Letters Patent an Administrator shall administer the government of the State if and so long as the Governor, not having appointed a deputy under clause XVI, is on leave.
3. Under clause XIII of those Letters Patent the Lieutenant-Governor shall be the Administrator.
4. By a Commission under the Royal Sign Manual dated 19 March 1990 Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second appointed me, David Kingsley Malcolm, to be Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Western Australia, during Her Majesty's pleasure.
5. I now proclaim and declare that I have today assumed the administration of the government of the State, and that, under clause XIV of those Letters Patent, I have and may perform and exercise the powers and functions of the Governor.
