WILDLIFE CONSERVATION ACT 1950

WILDLIFE CONSERVATION (ACCLIMATISED FAUNA) NOTICE 1992 Made by the Minister under section 14.

Citation

1. This notice may be cited as the Wildlife Conservation (Acclimatised Fauna) Notice 1992.

Interpretation

2. In this notice-

- "acclimatised fauna" means fauna living in a wild state as a result of being released or escaping from confinement or because it is the immediate or remoter offspring of fauna that has been released or has escaped from confinement;
- "south-west division" means that part of the State described as the south-west division in section 28 of the Land Act 1933;
- "tree" includes a dead tree;
- "wild state" means in an independent unpossessed or natural state and not held in a domesticated or captive state.

Declaration of an open season

3. Subject to clause 4, an open season in respect of acclimatised fauna referred to in the Schedule is declared throughout the south-west division (*),

Restrictions on taking acclimatised fauna

- 4. A person taking acclimatised fauna shall not take the fauna—
 - (a) in such a manner as to cause damage or is likely to cause damage to any tree or part of a tree;
 - (b) by the use of a trap unless he holds a relevant licence under the Wildlife Conservation Regulations 1970 authorising the use of a trap.

Cancellation

- 5. The notices made by the Minister under section 14 of the Wildlife Conservation Act 1950 and published in the Gazette—
 - (a) on the 28 February 1986 at p.624 in respect of the fauna referred to in item 1 of the Schedule; and
 - (b) on 25 August 1989 at p.2851 in respect of the fauna referred to in item 2 of the Schedule,

are cancelled.

BUSH FIRES ACT 1954

Shire of Tammin Firebreak Order

Notice to all owners and/or occupiers of land in the Shire of Tammin.

Pursuant to the powers contained in section 33 of the above Act, you are hereby required on or before 1st November 1993, to plough, scarify, spray, cultivate or otherwise clear and thereafter, maintain free of all flammable material until 1st March 1993, firebreaks in the following position and of the following dimensions, on the land owned or occupied by you.

1. Rural Land

- (i) Construct firebreaks of not less than 2.5 metres in width around the boundary of all standing crops and that the maximum area of standing crop to 200 hectares and around the external boundary of each property, such break to be not more than 20 metres inside the boundary fence.
- (ii) Clear and maintain firebreaks at least 2.5 metres wide within 20 metres of the perimeter of any building or group of buildings or hay stacks, in such a manner as to completely encircle the building or hay stack.

All townsite lots within the Shire of Tammin are required to be cleared and maintained free of all inflammable material.

For the purpose of this season inflammable material means dead grass and timber, boxes, cartons, paper and any combustible material or rubbish but does not include living trees and bushes and shrubs and plants in gardens.

3. Fuel Dumps and/or Depots

All grass or inflammable materials to be cleared from areas where drum ramps are located and where drums, full or empty are stored and such areas are to be maintained free of grass and similar inflammable material until 1st March 1993.

For the purpose of this section inflammable material means dead grass and timber, boxes, cartons, paper and any combustible material or rubbish but does not include living trees and bushes.

Prohibited burning, period from 7th November 1992 to 7th February 1993.

Restricted burning from 14th October 1992 to 6th November 1992 and 8th February 1993 to 22nd March 1993.

General Provisions

If it is considered to be impracticable for any reason to provide firebreaks in the position or adhere to the provisions required by this notice, the approval of the Council must be obtained to prepare such firebreaks in an alternative position. Approval to any such variation will only be granted where the Bush Fire Control Officer for the area has first signified approval for the variation. (Examples of reasons to relocate firebreak include where there are natural firebreaks or areas liable to soil erosion.)

The penalty to failing to comply with this notice is a fine of not less than \$40 nor more than \$400 and a person in default is also liable, whether prosecuted or not, to pay the cost of performing the work directed in this notice if it is not carried out by the owner or occupier and by the date required by this notice.

If the requirements of this notice are carried out by burning such burning must be in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Bush Fires Act.

GOVERNMENT RAILWAYS ACT 1904 BY-LAW 54 AMENDMENT (No. 2) 1992

Made by the Western Australian Government Railways Commission and approved by His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator in Executive Council.

1. These by-laws may be cited as By-law 54 Amendment (No. 2) 1992.
