Made by the Minister under section 31 (d).

Citation

1. This order may be cited as the *Environmental Protection (Peel Inlet-Harvey Estuary) Policy Approval Order 1992*.

Approval and commencement of environmental protection policy

2. The environmental protection policy set out in the Schedule —
- (a) is approved; and
 - (b) shall have the force of law on and from the day on which this order is published in the *Gazette*.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (PEEL INLET-HARVEY
ESTUARY) POLICY 1992

Approved by the Minister under section 31 (d).

PART 1 — PRELIMINARY

Citation

1. This policy may be cited as the *Environmental Protection (Peel Inlet-Harvey Estuary) Policy 1992*.

Purpose of policy

2. The purpose of this policy is —
 - (a) to set out environmental quality objectives for the Estuary which if achieved will rehabilitate the Estuary and protect the Estuary from further degradation; and
 - (b) to outline the means by which the environmental quality objectives for the Estuary are to be achieved and maintained.

Interpretation

3. In this policy, unless the contrary intention appears —
 - “environmental quality objectives” means the environmental quality objectives set out in clause 7;
 - “Estuary” means Peel Inlet and Harvey Estuary;
 - “median load (mass) of total phosphorus” means the middle observed phosphorus load in the observed series of measured annual phosphorus loads, measured over the immediately preceding 10 year period;
 - “Planning Policy” means “Statement of Planning Policy No. 2; The Peel-Harvey Coastal Plain Catchment” prepared by the State Planning Commission under the *Town Planning and Development Act 1928* and published in the *Gazette* of 21 February 1992 at pp. 947-955, and includes any amendments made to that Policy;
 - “policy area” means the portion of the environment to which this policy applies;
 - “this policy” means this environmental protection policy.

Application

4. The portion of the environment to which this policy applies is the area of land defined in Schedule 1.

**PART 2 — BASIS FOR PROTECTION OF ESTUARY,
ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY OBJECTIVES, AND
ACHIEVEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF THOSE OBJECTIVES**

Beneficial uses

5. The following uses of the Estuary are declared to be beneficial uses to be protected under this policy —
- (a) use of the Estuary as a resource for studying the natural environment;
 - (b) use of the Estuary as a habitat for diverse and abundant native flora and fauna communities;
 - (c) use of the Estuary to support commercial and amateur fisheries;
 - (d) use of the Estuary for recreation, tourism and landscape amenity;
 - (e) use of the Estuary as a focus for residential development.

Basis for protection of Estuary

6. (1) Nutrient enrichment of the Estuary has been caused by the clearing of native vegetation in the policy area and by land uses that result in nutrients, especially phosphorus, leaching into waterways in the policy area and then flowing into the Estuary.

(2) Nutrient enrichment in the Estuary has stimulated the excessive growth of algae, causing the degradation of the Estuary and creating a serious public nuisance.

Environmental quality objectives

7. The environmental quality objectives to be achieved and maintained in respect of the Estuary are a median load (mass) of total phosphorus flowing into the Estuary of less than 75 tonnes with —

- (a) the median load (mass) of total phosphorus flowing into the Estuary from the Serpentine River being less than 21 tonnes;
- (b) the median load (mass) of total phosphorus flowing into the Estuary from the Murray River being less than 16 tonnes; and
- (c) the median load (mass) of total phosphorus flowing into the Estuary from the Harvey River and drains being less than 38 tonnes.

Achievement and maintenance of environmental quality objectives

8. (1) The rehabilitation and protection of the Estuary is to be effected by the achievement and maintenance of the environmental quality objectives, objectives which will prevent excessive growth of algae in the Estuary.

(2) The environmental quality objectives are to be achieved and maintained through —

- (a) implementation of the Planning Policy by local authorities through their relevant town planning schemes, and by the State Planning Commission through the Metropolitan Region Scheme;

- (b) appropriate land management by landholders and management authorities in the policy area;
- (c) government extension services including the provision of advice to landholders in the policy area; and
- (d) local authorities and the State ensuring that decisions and actions are compatible with the achievement and maintenance of the environmental quality objectives.

 - Inserting the notation under the heading "Specified Area or Locality"—Special Rural Zone Area No. 8, Part Plantagenet Location 3250 Randall Road, Denmark.
 - Inserting the following special provision No. (1) to (8) inclusive, relating to Special Rural Zone Area No. 8: Part Plantagenet Location 3250 Randall Road, Denmark.

(1) Subdivision

- (a) Subdivision of Special Rural Zone Area No. 8 shall be generally in accordance with the Subdivision Guide Map (Plan No. 91/11/2) as signed by the Shire Clerk.
- (b) The State Planning Commission may approve minor variations to the subdivisional design, but further breakdown of lots created shall be deemed contrary to the provisions of the Scheme.

(2) Land Use

- (a) Within Special Rural Zone Area No. 8, no use will be permitted other than:
Residential Dwelling House;
- (b) Within Special Rural Zone Area No. 8, the following uses may be permitted with the approval of the Council:
Home Occupation;
- (c) With the intention of preventing overstocking, erosion or any other practices detrimental to the amenity within Special Rural Zone Area No. 8, intensive agricultural pursuits and the breeding or keeping of animals for commercial gain shall not be permitted.

(3) Building Envelopes

- (a) Any building on a lot must be erected within the Building Envelope defined on the Subdivision Guide Map (Plan No. 91/11/2) as adopted by Council.

- (b) Notwithstanding this requirement, Council may permit a variation to the location of a Building Envelope if it is shown to the satisfaction of Council and the State Planning Commission that the proposed location of the Building Envelope will not be detrimental to the landscape or the environment, and will not exceed 3 000 m² in area.
 - (c) Clearing of native vegetation for the erection of a dwelling with Council approval shall not exceed the approved building envelope. Parkland clearing may be permitted within the building envelope, ensuring that flammable material is controlled within 50 metres of all buildings.
- (4) Servicing Requirements
- (a) No dwelling shall be constructed or approved for construction unless an approved method of effluent disposal, and a minimum 92 000 litre water storage tank or an alternative method of water supply, has been incorporated into the approved plans, and no dwelling shall be considered fit for human habitation unless such supply of water and method of effluent disposal has been installed and is operating.
 - (b) Council shall require that a prospective purchaser of a lot is aware of the responsibility to install an individual supply of water and method of effluent disposal.
 - (c) Reference shall be made to the Department of Agriculture Guidelines relating to water storage, tank size and area of roof catchment.
- (5) Tree Preservation
- Within Special Rural Zone Area No. 8:
- (a) No indigenous trees or substantial vegetation shall be felled or removed except where;
 - (i) parkland clearing takes place within an approved building envelope;
 - (ii) trees are dead, diseased or dangerous;
 - (iii) the establishment of a firebreak is required under a regulation or by-law;
 - (iv) access to a building site is required and approved;
 - (v) an area up to one metre in width for the purpose of erecting and maintaining a fenceline is required and approved by Council. In these areas, the land shall be slashed with a view to preventing soil erosion.
 - (b) Removal of indigenous trees or substantial vegetation for any purpose other than the—above exceptions, shall require the Consent of Council and as a condition—of granting consent, Council may require the planting and maintenance, for a period of at least 3 years, of endemic native trees of species and in locations approved by Council.
- (6) Tree Planting
- (a) Within the Tree Planting Areas nominated on the Subdivision Guide Map, Council shall require the subdivider to plant and maintain for a period of three years, endemic native trees of species and in locations approved by Council.
 - (b) The following species are preferred within the Tree Planting Areas as shown on the Subdivision Guide Map (No. 91/11/2):
 - Eucalyptus Calophylla (Marri)
 - Eucalyptus Occidentalis (Flat Topped Yate)
 - Agonis Juniperina (Swamp Wattle)
 - Melaleuca Cuticularis (Salt Paperbark)
 - Eucalyptus Staeri (Blackbutt)
 - Melaleuca Raphiophylla (Narrow Leaf Paperbark).
- (7) Fire Control
- (a) Strategic Fire Breaks and standpipe facilities, as nominated on the Subdivision Guide Map, shall be provided as a condition of subdivision and constructed to a standard approved by the Council and Bush Fires Board.
 - (b) Council shall require that a prospective purchaser of a lot is aware of his/her responsibility to maintain Strategic Fire Breaks, where that Strategic Fire Break crosses his/her lot.
 - (c) To maintain access for fire fighting purposes, a well maintained external access track along the inside boundary of the building envelope and limited clearing around all building structures shall be required by Council.
 - (d) Clearing of fire breaks along fencelines other than for Strategic Fire Breaks will not be encouraged unless for safety reasons to comply with Council and Bush Fires Board requirements.
- (8) Amenity Control
- (a) All buildings constructed within the zone shall be sympathetic to existing landscape elements (namely landform and vegetation) in terms of their design, materials and colour.

- (b) Buildings shall be constructed of roof and external wall materials comprising natural earth or olive green colours. Zincalume and other coloured roof and external wall materials which would, in the opinion of Council, prejudice the landscape amenity of the area, will not be permitted.
- (c) All residential buildings shall be single storey except where it can be proven to Council that a variation to the height restriction would not adversely affect the visual amenity of the locality.
- (d) All buildings shall be sited to maximise the natural screening effect of vegetation and topography.
- (e) Proposals to vary the height restrictions pursuant to Special Provision 8(c) shall be accompanied by such plans, elevations and sketches as is determined by the Council to assess the effect on the visual amenity and the natural screening effect of vegetation and topography.

(9) Requirement for Survey Plan

A surveyor's plan (pre-calculation drawing) shall be lodged with Council prior to the clearance of diagrams of survey and show tree preservation areas, strategic firebreaks, building envelopes, and roads and drains as proposed and as required by Council for approval.
