5.3.1 For the purpose of this Scheme "Residential Planning Codes" means the Residential Planning Codes set out in Appendix 2 to the Statement of Planning Policy No. 1, together with any amendments thereto.

(B) Amending Clause 5.4 Residential Zones as follows—

(i) 5.4 Residential Zones

5.4.1 Residential A Zone

5.4.1.1 The purpose and intent of the "Residential A" Zone is to encourage a mix of single housing and medium density housing to encourage families to the district and increase the population.

5.4.1.2 Council may require applications for the development of more than two grouped or multiple dwellings to be advertised in accordance with Clause 6.2 and the Council may require the application to be modified having regard to submissions received on the proposed development.

5.4.1.3 (a) Except for the erection of a single house Council may refuse the development of grouped or multiple dwellings unless such housing is connected to a reticulated sewerage system.

(b) Where residential land abuts a regional road reserve, vehicular access to that road shall not be permitted for residential development other than for a single house, unless a vehicular access plan has been approved by the responsible authority(s).

5.4.1.4 (a) All residential development apart from a single house or an existing development is required to be connected to a reticulated sewerage system.

(b) If no sewerage is available, development in excess of the single house is not permitted unless such development complies with the requirements of the Government Sewerage Policy.

5.4.1.5 Dual Code R20/R40

(a) Notwithstanding the dual code of R20/R40, the R12.5 Code shall apply to those properties within or partly within the noise zone of 25-30 ANEC (Australian Noise Exposure Concept—Ultimate Capacity) for Perth Airport, as shown in Schedule X.

(b) The Council shall decide the appropriate R Code between R20 and R40 of the Residential Planning codes for each street block or part thereof, the subject of the dual code R20/R40 taking into account relevant statements of planning policy adopted by Council pursuant to Clause 5.16.

(ii) Deleting redundant Clauses 5.4.2 and 5.4.2.1.

(C) Deleting from Table 1—Zoning Table the Use Class of "Attached House" and renumber accordingly.

(D) Including under Schedule X a map entitled "Noise Zone of 25-30 ANEC (Australian Noise Exposure Concept—Ultimate Capacity) Perth Airport".

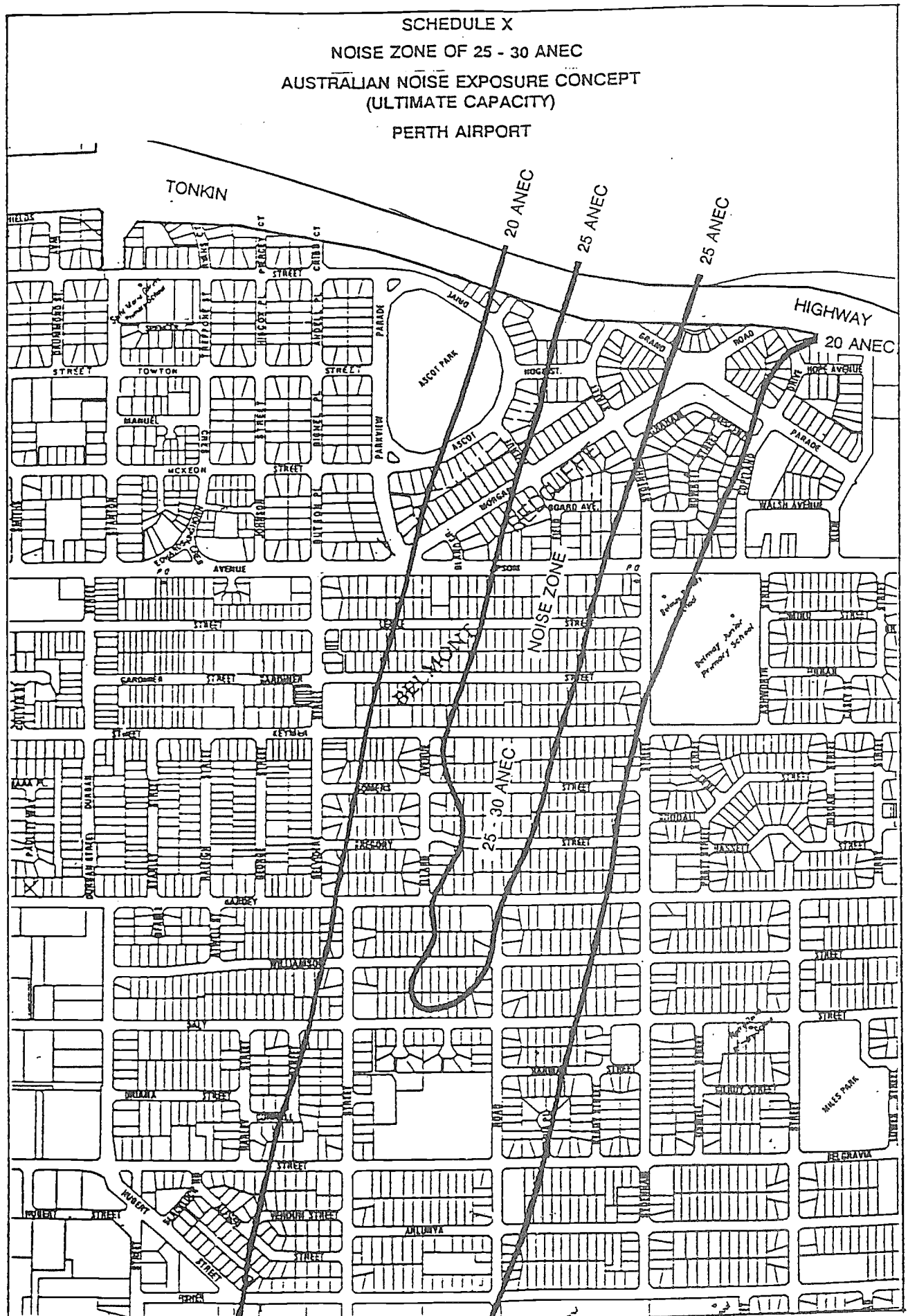

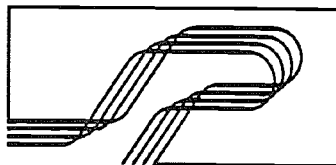


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
