PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA FRANCIS BURT, Governor. [L.S.] By His Excellency the Honourable Sir Francis
Theodore Page Burt, Companion of the Order of
Australia, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint
George, Queen's Counsel, Governor of the State
of Western Australia.

By this proclamation, I, the Governor, acting under section 3 of the Constitution Act 1889, fix Parliament House in the City of Perth on Thursday, 17 June 1993 at 11.00 a.m. as the place and time for holding the First Session of the Thirty-fourth Parliament.
