HUMAN REPRODUCTIVE TECHNOLOGY ACT NOTICE

It is hereby notified for public information that the Minister for Health has approved the keeping of registers under section 45 of the Human Reproductive Technology Act in the place and manner set out below:

- 1. The registers are to be kept at the Health Services Statistics and Epidemiology Branch of the Health Department of Western Australia, 189 Royal Street, East Perth.
- 2. The registers are to be kept on computer.
- 3. There shall be separately maintained:
 - (a) a register of information supplied by or otherwise obtained from licensees in respect of in vitro fertilisation procedures (the IVF Register);
 - (b) a register containing information supplied by, or otherwise obtained from licensees in respect of donors and children born of donor gametes or embryos (the Donor Register);
 - (c) a register showing the prescribed information relating to licences, licensees, managers and persons to whom an exemption applies (the Licence Register);
 - (d) a register setting out a record of disciplinary proceedings under the Act (the Disciplinary Register);
- 4. The IVF Register and Donor Register shall be kept on computer in a restricted access system, as defined in section 440A of the Criminal Code.
- 5. The Code of Practice of the Confidentiality of Health Information Committee of the Health Department of Western Australia (CHIC) for the use of name identified data from the Health Statistical data collections shall apply to all use of name identified data from the IVF Register and Donor Register.
- 6. Where the name, postcode of residence, date of birth or occupation of any participant or child born is registered this information shall not be stored on computer but kept separately under secure conditions at all times, other than for any temporary use necessary to link records from various sources after which all identifying information must be removed from the computer.
