 - 39A. For the purposes of section 107(1), an amusement with prizes which constitutes gaming or a lottery or both which is provided in relation to or in connection with any entertainment or sporting event is unlawful if
 - (a) the amount paid for a chance to win a prize exceeds \$2.00;
 - (b) the maximum prize to be distributed exceeds \$10.00 or \$10.00 worth; or
 - (c) the amusement with prizes is conducted at any time other than during the entertainment or sporting event to which it relates.






