2 November 1993

Notice to owners and/or occupiers of land outside the Metropolitan Fire District in the Shire of Swan.

Pursuant to the powers contained in section 33 of the above Act you are hereby required on or before the 2nd November 1993 to remove from the land owned or occupied by you all inflammable material or to clear firebreaks in accordance with the following and thereafter to maintain the land or the firebreaks clear of inflammable material up to and including the 31st day of March, 1994.

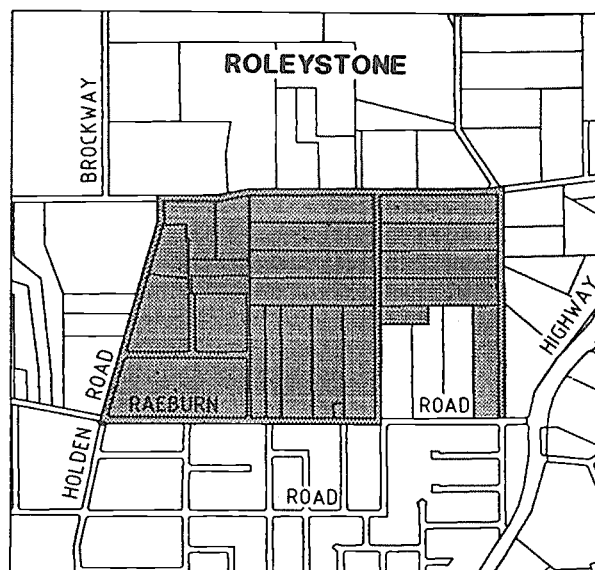

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

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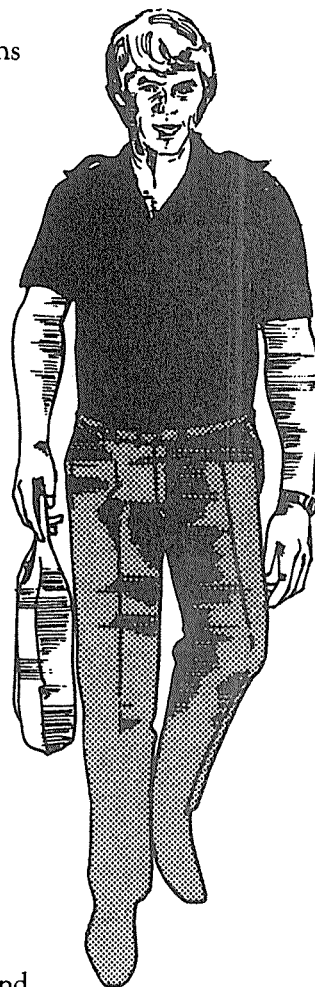
