WILDLIFE CONSERVATION (RESTRICTED OPEN SEASON FOR WILD DUCKS CAUSING DAMAGE) NOTICE 1994

Made by the Minister under section 14.

Citation

1. This notice may be cited as the *Wildlife Conservation (Restricted Open Season for Wild Ducks Causing Damage) Notice 1994*.

Interpretation

2. In this notice —

“**managed farmland**” means land wholly or principally used for agriculture, horticulture, grazing, dairying, viticulture, or other similar farming purposes;

“**municipal district**” has the same meaning as in the *Local Government Act 1960*;

“**Perth Metropolitan Region**” means the metropolitan region as defined in section 6 of the *Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act 1959* and the municipal district of the City of Mandurah;

“**South-west Division**” and “**Eucla Division**” mean those areas of the State as defined in section 28 of the *Land Act 1933*;

“**restricted open season area**” means the South-west Division and the Eucla Division, excluding those municipal districts within the Perth Metropolitan Region;

“**wild duck**” means fauna listed in Schedule 1.

Declaration of a restricted open season

3. Subject to clauses 4, 5 and 6, an open season is declared in respect of the fauna listed in Schedule 1 in the restricted open season area for the periods —

date of publication of this notice
in the *Gazette* to 30 June 1994;

- 1 January 1995 to 30 June 1995;
- 1 January 1996 to 30 June 1996;
- 1 January 1997 to 30 June 1997; and
- 1 January 1998 to 30 June 1998.

Restrictions on taking wild ducks

4. (1) Wild ducks may be taken only —

- (a) by a person (or the person's nominated agent or nominated shooter) on managed farmland or other damaged land that the person owns or occupies;
- (b) in the case of managed farmland, when the wild ducks are causing damage, or when reasonably expected to cause damage, to that land;
- (c) in the case of other damaged land, when authorized by a wildlife officer;
- (d) by means of a 12 gauge shotgun in respect of which the person holds a licence or permit under the *Firearms Act 1973*; and
- (e) between the hours of sunrise and sunset.

(2) In subclause (1) —

"other damaged land" means land which a wildlife officer has inspected and considers to be significantly damaged by wild ducks;

"nominated agent" means a person who is the owner or occupier of land adjacent to the land on which the wild ducks are to be taken, who has the verbal approval of the owner of that land to take the wild ducks;

"nominated shooter" means one of up to 3 persons who is —

- (a) nominated in writing for a specified period by the owner or occupier of the managed farmland or other damaged land; and
- (b) approved by a wildlife officer.

(3) A nominated shooter shall carry evidence of his nomination by the owner or occupier at all times when on the land for the purpose of taking wild ducks or when transporting wild ducks taken.

Further restrictions on taking wild ducks

5. (1) A person shall not take or attempt to take a wild duck unless it can be positively identified as a species of wild duck listed in Schedule 1.

(2) A person shall not take or attempt to take a fledgling or an egg of a species of wild duck listed in Schedule 1.

(3) A person shall not —

- (a) shoot over or from —
 - (i) any land or waters outside the restricted open season area;
or
 - (ii) any Crown land or waters vested in the Crown;
or
- (b) flush, drive or otherwise induce wild ducks from —
 - (i) any land or waters outside the restricted open season area;
or
 - (ii) any Crown land or waters vested in the Crown,

in order to take or attempt to take wild ducks in accordance with this notice.

(4) A person shall not take a wild duck for the purpose of sale, aviculture or keeping in captivity.

(5) A person shall not possess or transport a wild duck unless at least one fully feathered wing is attached to the wild duck.

Damage licence may be required to take wild ducks on certain land

6. (1) After inspecting any land, a wildlife officer may prohibit the taking of wild ducks on that land.

(2) If the taking of wild ducks on land is prohibited under subclause (1), a person may only take wild ducks on that land under the authority of a damage licence issued under the *Wildlife Conservation Regulations 1970*.

Notice No. 600

Made by the Minister under section 32.

Citation

1. This notice may be cited as the *Kimberley Prawn Limited Entry Fishery Notice 1993*.

Interpretation

2. In this notice unless the contrary intention appears
 - "approved form" means in a form approved by the Director;
 - "authorised boat" means a boat which is authorised by licence or endorsement to be used to take prawns from the waters of the Fishery;
 - "boat units" means boat units calculated in accordance with the formula specified in Schedule 3;
 - "Class A units" means Class A units as referred to in the Northern Prawn Fishery Management Plan**;
 - "Class B unit" means a Class B unit as referred to in the Northern Prawn Fishery Management Plan**;
 - "code" means the Uniform Shipping Laws Code adopted by the Marine and Ports Council of Australia and published in the *Commonwealth of Australia Gazette* on 11 May 1981;
 - "fish" means all species of fish except for prawns;
 - "Fishery" means the Kimberley Prawn Limited Entry Fishery as declared in Clause 3;
 - "licence" means a licence authorising a boat to be operated in the Fishery;
 - "prawns" means all species of decapod crustacea of the family Penaeidae and the infra order Caridea; and
 - "transferred" means the passing of ownership or effective control of a licence from one person to another person.

Declaration of limited entry fishery

3. It is hereby declared that the taking of prawns from the waters described in Schedule 1 shall constitute a limited entry fishery to be called the Kimberley Prawn Limited Entry Fishery.

Prohibition on taking prawns

4. A person, other than a person to whom section 32 (5) of the Act applies, shall not take, or attempt to take, prawns by any means in the waters described in Schedule 1—
 - (a) other than in accordance with the provisions of this notice;
 - (b) unless that person is operating from a boat which is an authorised boat.

Prohibition on selling or dealing

5. A person shall not sell or deal or attempt to sell or deal with prawns taken from the Fishery unless those prawns were taken—
 - (a) in accordance with the provisions of this notice;
 - (b) by the holder of a professional fisherman's licence when operating from an authorised boat.

Class of licence

6. A licence issued to authorise a boat to operate in the Fishery shall be either a Class 1 licence, a Class 2 licence or a Class 3 licence.

Criteria to determine the boats which may operate in the Fishery (Class 1 licence)

7. (1) The criteria that shall be applied to determine the boats which may operate in the Fishery are that—
 - (a) as at 9 November 1990 the boat was licensed under Regulation 2 of the *Fisheries Regulations 1938** and that licence was endorsed to permit the boat to be used to take prawns by means of trawling in all Western Australian waters of the Indian Ocean and Timor Sea off the Kimberley coast between 123° east longitude and 127° east longitude; and
 - (b) immediately before the date this notice commences operation the boat was licensed under Regulation 2 of the *Fisheries Regulations 1938**.
- (2) The licensee of a boat which fulfils the criteria specified in subclause (1) of this clause may apply within 60 days of the date this notice commences operation in accordance with clause 20 for a Class 1 licence.

Retention of a Class 1 licence (Following compulsory reduction of Class A units)

8. The licensee of a boat authorised to operate in the Northern Prawn Fishery** and who, in accordance with the Northern Prawn Fishery Management Plan, as at 1 April 1993 suffered a compulsory reduction of Class A units assigned to the boat and the Class B unit was still assigned to the boat, may within 60 days of the date this notice commences operation apply in writing in accordance with clause 20 and with the written approval of a licensing officer retain the Class 1 licence to the Fishery.

Class 2 licence

9. (1) The licensee of a boat which qualifies for access to the Fishery in accordance with clause 7 and—

- (a) the boat does not have a Western Australian fishing boat registration number in the sequence LFBP200 to LFBP500 inclusive;
- (b) the boat is not endorsed on another limited entry fishery licence authorising the boat to be used in either the Shark Bay Prawn Limited Entry Fishery***, the Exmouth Gulf Prawn Limited Entry Fishery**** or the Nickol Bay Prawn Limited Entry Fishery*****;
- (c) (i) prior to 1 April 1993 transferred or surrendered the Class A units assigned to the boat to a level below that required to operate the boat in the Northern Prawn Fishery** and the Class B unit formerly attached to the boat is unassigned; or
(ii) on or after 1 April 1993 transferred or surrendered by any means other than an adjustment scheme either all the Class A units attached to the boat or sufficient of the Class A units attached to the boat so that the boat no longer retains access to the Northern Prawn Fishery** and the Class B unit is unassigned; or
(iii) after 1 April 1993 as a result of a Commonwealth adjustment scheme, there is a change of status to any of the licences or endorsements attached to the boat to which the Kimberley Prawn Limited Entry Fishery Licence is issued and as a result of the change of status the boat no longer retains access to the Northern Prawn Fishery** and the Class B unit formerly assigned to the boat is unassigned; or
(iv) after 1 April 1993 as a result of a fisheries adjustment scheme established under this Act, there is a change of status to any of the licences or endorsements giving access to the Shark Bay Prawn Limited Entry Fishery***, the Exmouth Gulf Prawn Limited Entry Fishery**** or the Nickol Bay Prawn Limited Entry Fishery***** which are attached to the boat to which the Kimberley Prawn Limited Entry Fishery Licence is issued and as a result of the change of status the boat no longer retains access to a Western Australian trawl fishery other than the Fishery; and
- (d) does not have any other access authorisation qualifying the boat for access to the Fishery; or
- (e) does not have any other access approved by the Minister,

shall within 60 days of the date this notice commences operation or the transfer of the units takes place or the status of the licence or endorsement changes surrender to the Minister the Class 1 licence and apply in accordance with clause 20 for a Class 2 Kimberley Prawn Limited Entry Fishery Licence.

(2) The licensee of a boat as described in subclause (1) who does not apply for a Class 2 licence may apply in accordance with clause 20 to have the Class 1 licence cancelled and be paid compensation.

(3) The amount of compensation paid shall be at the sole discretion of the Minister.

(4) If the licensee of a boat as described in subclause (1) does not apply within 60 days in accordance with clause 20 for either a Class 2 licence or for compensation in accordance with subclause (2) the Class 1 licence shall be cancelled.

(5) Any licence surrendered or cancelled under the provisions of this clause shall not be reissued.

Class 3 Licence (Reduction of Northern Prawn Fishery units after 1 April 1993)

10. (1) The licensee of a boat which qualifies for access to the Fishery under the provisions of a Class 1 licence and who—

- (a) does not have to surrender that licence under the provisions of Clause 9;
- (b) after 1 April 1993 reduces the Class A units attached to the boat by any means other than a compulsory adjustment scheme to either 100 units or to a number which is less than the number required to permit the boat to operate in the Northern Prawn Fishery**;
- (c) retains the Class B unit attached to the boat; and

- (d) does not have any other access authorisation qualifying the boat for access to the Fishery,

may within 60 days of reducing the Class A units to the level described in part (b) of this clause surrender the Class 1 licence and apply in accordance with clause 20 for a Class 3 licence.

(2) The licensee of a boat as described in subclause (1) who does not apply for a Class 3 licence may apply in accordance with clause 20 to have the Class 1 licence cancelled and be paid compensation.

(3) If the licensee of a boat as described in subclause (1) does not apply within 60 days in accordance with clause 20 for either a Class 3 licence or for compensation in accordance with subclause (2) the Class 1 licence shall be cancelled.

(4) The amount of compensation paid shall be at the sole discretion of the Minister.

(5) If at any time after the licensee is issued with a Class 3 licence there is a change of status to the Northern Prawn Fishery access such that the Class B unit formerly assigned to the boat becomes unassigned then the licensee shall surrender the Class 3 licence and may apply in accordance with clause 20 for a Class 2 licence.

(6) The licensee of a boat as described in subclause (5) who does not apply for a Class 2 licence may apply in accordance with clause 20 to have the Class 3 licence cancelled and be paid compensation.

(7) If the licensee of a boat as described in subclause (5) does not apply within 60 days in accordance with clause 20 for either a Class 2 licence or for compensation then the Class 3 licence shall be cancelled.

(8) The amount of compensation paid shall be at the sole discretion of the Minister.

(9) Any licence surrendered or cancelled under the provisions of this clause shall not be reissued.

Conversion of a Class 3 licence to a Class 1 licence

11. (1) The licensee of a boat operating in the Fishery under the provisions of a Class 3 licence may, upon purchasing sufficient units to qualify for full access to the Northern Prawn Fishery**, apply in accordance with clause 20 to surrender the Class 3 licence and for the issue of a Class 1 licence.

(2) The provisions of subclause (1) of this clause shall only apply to the holder of a current Class 3 licence.

Restricted operation of specified licences

12. (1) A boat authorised to operate in the Fishery under a Class 1 licence and the Licensed Fishing Boat registration number for that boat is within the sequence LFBP200 to LFBP500 inclusive shall—

- (a) take or attempt to take prawns from the waters of the Fishery only;
- (b) take or attempt to take prawns by the method of demersal trawling only; and
- (c) not take or attempt to take prawns or fish from any other Western Australian waters.

(2) A boat authorised to operate in the Fishery under a Class 2 or Class 3 licence shall—

- (a) take or attempt to take prawns from the waters of the Fishery only;
- (b) take or attempt to take prawns by the method of demersal trawling only; and
- (c) not take or attempt to take prawns or fish by means of trawling from any other Western Australian waters.

Cancellation of a licence

13. (1) The licensee of a boat which qualified for access in accordance with clause 7 and—

- (a) the boat has a Western Australian fishing boat registration number in the sequence LFBP200 to LFBP500 inclusive;
- (b) the boat does not have access to either the Shark Bay Prawn Limited Entry Fishery***, the Exmouth Gulf Prawn Limited Entry Fishery**** or the Nickol Bay Prawn Limited Entry Fishery*****;
- (c) and who at any time after 9 November 1990 loses access to the Northern Prawn Fishery** by any means whatsoever; and
- (d) does not have any other access authorisation qualifying the boat for access to the Fishery,

shall have any access endorsement or licence to the Fishery cancelled.

(2) A Class 2 licence or Class 3 licence attached to a boat which exceeds 375 boat units at 1 April 1996 or three years after being granted a Class 2 licence, whichever is the later, shall be cancelled.

(3) For the purpose of subclause (2) boat units shall be calculated in accordance with the formula as specified in Schedule 3.

(4) The licensee of any authorised boat, or its replacement which—

(a) loses access to the Fishery by any means whatsoever;

(b) has a Western Australian licensed fishing boat number in the sequence LFBP200-LFBP500 inclusive; and

(c) does not have access to any other Western Australian trawl fishery,

shall not use that boat to take any fish or prawns by any means in any Western Australian waters.

Publication of details

14. The Director may from time to time give notice of—

(a) the names of licensees;

(b) the names and registrations numbers of boats authorised to operate in the Fishery; and

(c) the Class of licence issued to any boat,

by publishing that information in such a manner as deemed appropriate.

Details on a licence

15. A licence shall contain the following details—

(a) the name and licensed fishing boat number in respect of which it is issued;

(b) the name and address of the owner or licensee of that boat;

(c) the licence number;

(d) the day of issue;

(e) the period for which the licence is valid;

(f) the Class of licence; and

(g) any conditions imposed on the licence.

Authorised means of operating in the Fishery

16. Unless otherwise authorised in writing by the Minister a person shall not take or attempt to take prawns from the waters of the Fishery other than by a maximum of two trawl nets with a combined maximum headrope length of 51.25 metres.

Closed seasons

17. (1) All persons are prohibited from taking any species of prawns by means of trawling from—

(a) (i) 0600 hours western standard time on 1 December in any year to 0600 hours western standard time on 1 April next following; and

(ii) 1000 hours western standard time on 8 June in any year to 1600 hours western standard time on 1 August next following,

in the waters specified in Schedule 1; and

(b) 0600 hours western standard time on 1 December in any year to 1600 hours western standard time on 1 August next following in the waters specified in Schedule 2.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subclause (1) the Minister may, in writing, declare the times and dates during which prawns may or may not be taken from any specified area of the Fishery.

Transfer of a licence

18. (1) Subject to the prior written approval of the Director, the holder of a Class 1 licence issued for a boat which—

(a) as at 9 November 1990—

(i) was licensed under Regulation 2 of the *Fisheries Regulations 1938** and the licence was endorsed to permit the boat to take prawns by means of trawling in all Western Australian waters of the Indian Ocean and Timor Sea off the Kimberley coast between 123° east longitude and 127° east longitude;

(ii) did not have access to the Northern Prawn Fishery**;

- (b) does not have a Western Australian registration number in the sequence LFBP200 to LFBP500; and
- (c) does not have access to either the Northern Prawn Fishery**, the Shark Bay Prawn Limited Entry Fishery***, the Exmouth Gulf Prawn Limited Entry Fishery**** or the Nickol Bay Prawn Limited Entry Fishery*****,

may transfer that licence to another person if either the boat retains, together with the Western Australian Fishing Boat Licence, at least one access authorisation, access endorsement or applicable units for a Western Australian trawl fishery after the Kimberley Prawn Limited Entry Fishery licence is transferred or all licences together with the Western Australian Fishing Boat licence are transferred at the same time.

(2) Subject to the prior written approval of the Director the holder of a Class 1 licence issued for a boat which is not a boat as described in paragraphs (a), (b) or (c) of subclause (1) may transfer that licence to another person provided that all licences and endorsements for the boat are transferred at the same time as required by the 1987 Australian Fisheries Council licence splitting policy.

(3) Subject to the prior written approval of the Director, the holder of a Class 2 or Class 3 licence may transfer that licence to another person provided the Western Australian Fishing Boat Licence issued for the same boat is transferred with the Class 2 or Class 3 licence.

Boat replacement

19. (1) With the prior written approval of the Director, a boat authorised to operate in the Fishery under a Class 1 licence may be replaced by another boat if the replacement boat is equipped for prawn trawling.

(2) With the prior written approval of the Director, a boat authorised to operate in the Fishery under a Class 2 or Class 3 licence may be replaced by another boat if the replacement boat is equipped for prawn trawling and does not exceed 375 boat units as calculated in accordance with the formula as specified in Schedule 3.

(3) For the purpose of this Clause a boat is equipped for prawn trawling if—

- (a) more than one net is used;
- (b) the overall length of the trawl gear including sweeps, bridles and headrope exceeds 274.32 metres; and
- (c) the mesh of the trawl nets is less than 50 millimetres.

Applications and fees

20. Applications made under clauses 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 18 and 19 shall be made to the Director—

- (a) in the approved form;
- (b) lodged in accordance with the instructions if any; and
- (c) accompanied by the fee prescribed by Regulation.

Ministerial approval for access

21. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of clause 7 the licensee of a boat not authorised to operate in the Fishery may, on application and with the written approval of the Minister, be issued with an access endorsement to take prawns by means of trawling in the Fishery.

(2) An endorsement issued under this clause may be restricted to any specified area of the Fishery and to any specified time of operation.

Determination of position by reference to the Australian Geodetic Datum

22. (1) Where, for the purpose of this notice it is necessary to determine a position on the surface of the Earth by geographical coordinates, that position shall be determined on the Australian Geodetic Datum which is defined by an ellipsoid having a semi-major axis (equatorial radius) of 6 378 160 metres and a flattening of 1/298.25 and fixed by the position of the origin being the Johnston Geodetic Station in the Northern Territory of Australia.

(2) The Johnston Geodetic Station referred to in subclause (1) shall be taken to be situated at 25°56'54.5515" south latitude and at 133°12'30.0771" east longitude and to have a ground level elevation of 571.2 metres above the ellipsoid referred to in that subclause.

All Western Australian waters landward of a line drawn from Cape Pond in York Sound southwest to Ena Island; thence to the southern extremity of Desfontaines Island; thence to the southern extremity of Forbin Island; thence to the southern extremity of Commerson Island; thence south to the high water mark on the northern extremity of High Bluff on the mainland.

Collier Bay

2. All Western Australian waters off the Kimberley coast east of 124°00' east longitude and south of 15°50' south latitude.

Admiralty Gulf

3. All Western Australian waters of Admiralty Gulf on the landward side of a line drawn from a point on the mainland at the intersection of 14°19'32" south latitude and 126°04'30" east longitude drawn due west through Middle Osborne Island to the northern extremity of South West Osborne Island; thence south west to the northern extremity of Crystal Head; thence to the northern extremity of Pickering Point; thence north westerly to a point on the mainland at the intersection of 14°19'30" south latitude and 125°43'30" east longitude.

Schedule 3

"Boat units" means the units of a boat calculated by the formula—

ML means "measured length" as defined in the Code measured in accordance with Appendix A to Section 1 of the Code;

Carpark and Access Site for Edgewater Station—Westrail

In the notice appearing on page 2807 of *Government Gazette* dated June 4, 1993 (reference LA 101) delete in the second last line "of enactment" and substitute "applicable for valuation pursuant to Section 63A of the Public Works Act 1902".

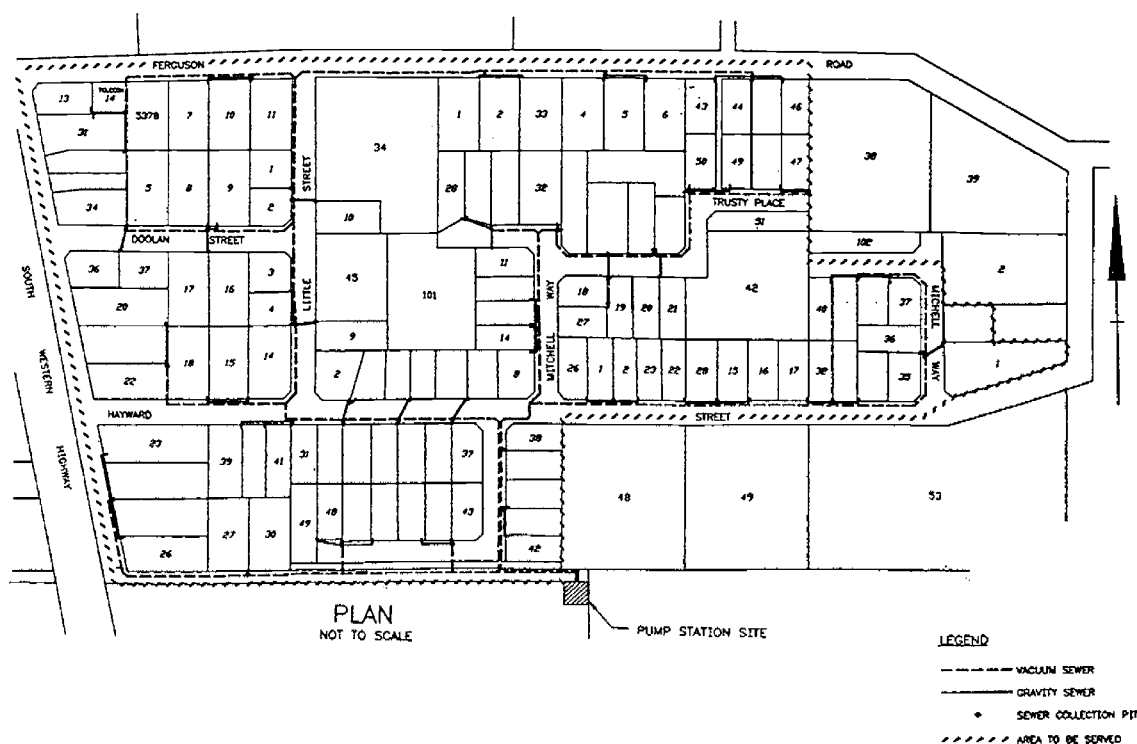

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
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
