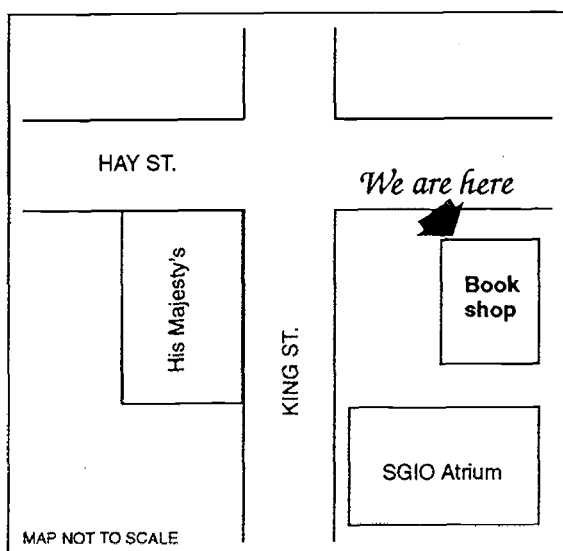

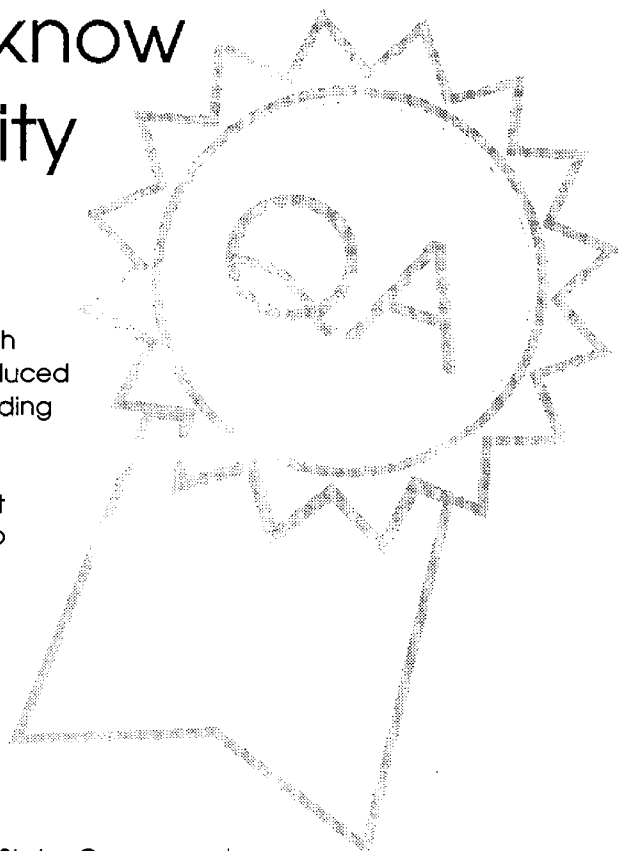
Do you want to know more about Quality Assurance?

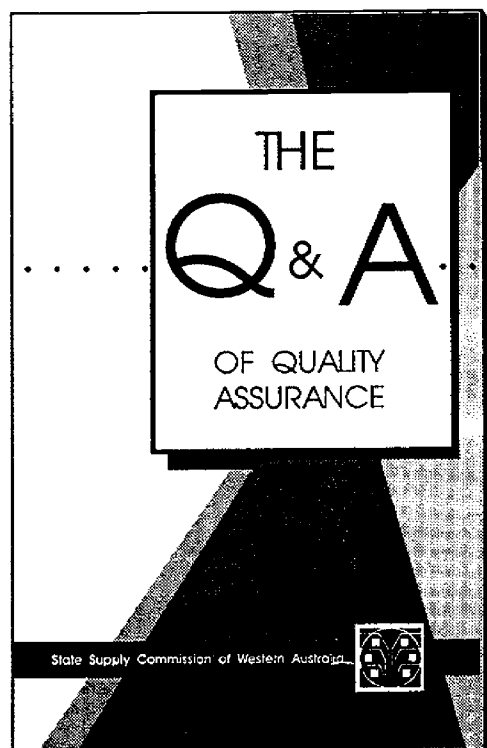
