#### Parasailing Area

Department of Transport, Fremantle, 8 June 1994.

Acting pursuant to the powers conferred under Regulation 48A (1) of the Navigable Waters Regulations, the Department of Transport by this notice declares the following area of navigable waters as a parasailing area—

Shire of Carnarvon—Ningaloo Marine Park.

All those waters contained within an area commencing 50 metres south and 100 metres off Monck Head extending due west for 400 metres and within two lines drawn due south from those points for 1000 metres towards Five Finger Reef. Providing however no parasailer or vessel towing a parasailer will come within 100 metres of any other person, vessel or object in the water.

Further providing that the area is set aside for commercial parasailing operations only and that only one commercial parasailing operator is permitted to operate within the area, who must be approved for commercial operations by the Department of Conservation and Land Management. Public parasailing is not permitted within the above area.




