The State Planning Commission has considered all the submissions received in respect of the amendment proposals for the "Burswood Bridge and Road" (No. 933/33). This proposal was first published in the *Government Gazette* on September 24, 1993. As a result of the submissions received the Commission has modified the amendment proposal.
