BUSH FIRES ACT 1954

Shire of Cuballing

If the requirements of this notice are carried out by burning, such burning must be in accordance with the relevant provision of the Bush Fires Act 1954.

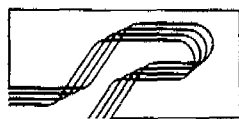
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
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
