JUSTICE**JM301****DISTRICT COURT OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA ACT 1969**

Pursuant to the powers conferred by the *District Court of Western Australian Act 1969*, and all other powers hereunto enabling, the Judges of the District Court of Western Australia hereby make the following rule.

Principal Rules

1. 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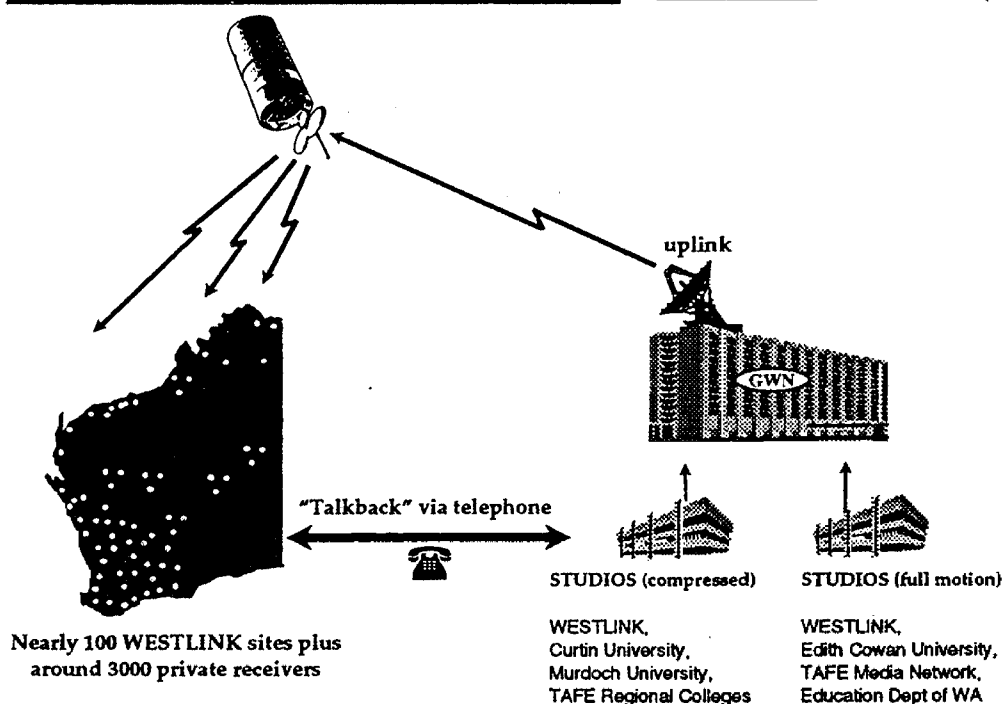
