WILDLIFE CONSERVATION ACT 1950

WILDLIFE CONSERVATION (CLOSE SEASON FOR BOTTLENOSE DOLPHINS IN SHARK BAY MARINE PARK) NOTICE 1995

Made by the Minister under section 14 (2) (a).

Citation

1. This notice may be cited as the Wildlife Conservation (Close Season for Bottlenose Dolphins in Shark Bay Marine Park) Notice 1995.

Object of this notice

2. The object of this notice is to restrict the supply by humans of food to bottlenose dolphins in the Shark Bay Marine Park so as to protect the dolphins from disturbance; namely, interference with the natural feeding patterns of infant and adult dolphins that increases the dolphins vulnerability to disease, injury and death.

Interpretation

- In this notice
 - "bottlenose dolphin" means the fauna Tursiops truncatus;
 - "feed" means to supply matter that is likely to be eaten by bottlenose dolphins and includes offering such matter or leaving such matter in a place that is accessible to bottlenose dolphins and also includes attempting, or assisting another person, to do any of those things;
 - "specified area" means the Shark Bay Marine Park, reserved by Order in Council* as Class "A" Marine Reserve No. 7.
 - [* Published in Gazette of 30 November 1990 at p. 5898.]

Declaration of a close season

- 4. (1) A close season is declared in respect of the feeding of bottlenose dolphins in the specified area.
- (2) The close season is for the period commencing on the day on which this notice is published in the Gazette until the day on which this notice is cancelled or this clause is varied by a notice under section 14 (2) (b) of the Act.

Restriction on feeding bottlenose dolphins

- 5. A person must not feed a bottlenose dolphin that is in the specified area unless
 - (a) the person has the written authority of the Executive Director to do so and is acting in accordance with the authority; or
 - (b) the person does so under the supervision of a person to whom paragraph (a) applies,

and the feeding takes place at the intertidal area of Red Cliff Bay, near Monkey Mia.

Otherwise authorized under Act

6. Clause 5 does not apply to a person who is authorized under the Act to feed bottlenose dolphins if the feeding is in accordance with the authorization. For example: a licence issued under regulation 17 of the Wildlife Conservation Regulations 1970.
