HEALTH ACT 1911

HEALTH (NOTIFICATION OF ADVERSE EVENT AFTER **IMMUNIZATION) REGULATIONS 1995**

Made by the deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Health (Notification of Adverse Event After Immunization) Regulations 1995.

Interpretation

In these regulations —

"adverse event after immunization" means —

- any one or more of the following conditions suffered by a (a) person within 48 hours of immunization -
 - (i) screaming that continues for more than 3 hours;
 - (ii) a temperature of 40.5°C that cannot reasonably be attributed to any other cause;
 - (iii) anaphylaxis;
 - (iv) shock; or
 - (**v**) a hypotonic or hyporesponsive episode;

- (b) any one or more of the following conditions suffered by a person within 30 days of immunization
 - (i) encephalopathy;
 - (ii) convulsions;
 - (iii) aseptic meningitis;
 - (iv) thrombocytopaenia; or
 - (v) acute flaccid paralysis;
- (c) the death of a person that occurs within 30 days of immunization; or
- (d) any other serious condition suffered by a person within 30 days of immunization if the condition is
 - (i) not reasonably attributable to any other cause; and
 - (ii) suspected of being associated with immunization;

"immunization", in relation to a person, means the administration to the person of a vaccine for the purpose of protecting the person against a disease.

Adverse event after immunization prescribed as condition of health

3. An adverse event after immunization is prescribed as a condition of health to which Part IXA of the Act applies.

Notification by medical practitioner

- 4. (1) A medical practitioner must notify the Executive Director, Public Health of an adverse event after immunization within 14 days of becoming aware of that adverse event.
 - (2) A notification under subregulation (1) must
 - (a) be in writing in a form approved by the Executive Director, Public Health; and
 - (b) include the following information
 - (i) a full description of the adverse event after immunization;
 - (ii) the full name of the person who suffered the adverse event after immunization and that person's address or telephone number;
 - (iii) where the adverse event after immunization is the death of a person, the full name, and the address or telephone number, of the next of kin or personal representative of the deceased person (if known);
 - (iv) the name, dose and batch number of the vaccine administered;
 - (v) the date on which the vaccine was administered;
 - (vi) the name and address of the place where the vaccine was administered; and
 - (vii) the full name, address and telephone number of the medical practitioner giving the notification.
- (3) A medical practitioner who contravenes subregulation (1) commits an offence and is liable to a penalty which is not more than \$1 000 and not less than
 - (a) in the case of a first offence, \$100;
 - (b) in the case of a second offence, \$200; and
 - (c) in the case of a third or subsequent offence, \$500.

Fee for notification

5. A fee of \$5 is payable to a medical practitioner who gives notification under regulation 4 but this regulation does not apply to a medical practitioner who is employed in the Public Service of the State or the Commonwealth, or is employed by an agency or instrumentality of the State or the Commonwealth.

Executive Director, Public Health may request provision of information

- 6. (1) Where the Executive Director, Public Health
 - (a) is notified of an adverse event after immunization; and
 - (b) has reasonable grounds to believe that a person is able to provide information relating to the adverse event,

the Executive Director, Public Health may request the person to provide such information relating to the adverse event as the Executive Director, Public Health considers necessary for the purpose of achieving the objects of Part IXA of the Act.

- (2) A person to whom a request is made under subregulation (1) must comply with the request within 14 days of receiving the request.
- (3) A person who, without reasonable excuse, contravenes subregulation (2) commits an offence and is liable to a penalty which is not more than \$1 000 and not less than
 - (a) in the case of a first offence, \$100;
 - (b) in the case of a second offence, \$200; and
 - (c) in the case of a third or subsequent offence, \$500.

HEALTH ACT 1911

City of Fremantle By-laws

The City of Fremantle being a Local Authority under the provisions of the abovementioned Act and having adopted the Model By-laws Series "A" made under the Act, does hereby in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Act and all other powers enabling it, make and publish the following by-laws.

- 1. In these By-laws the Model By-laws Series "A" as amended from time to time adopted by the City of Fremantle by resolution published in the *Government Gazette* of 13 May, 1964 are referred to as the Principal By-laws.
- 2. The By-law of the City of Fremantle relating to the removal of house and trade refuse published in the *Government Gazette* of 16 June 1970 is hereby revoked and the Principal By-laws are amended by deleting By-laws 12, 13, 14, 14A, 15, 15A and 16 of Part I and substituting the following—
 - "12. Interpretation

In this By-law and in By-laws 13 to 16 inclusive of this Part unless the context requires otherwise—

- "Building Line" has the meaning given to it in and for the purposes of the Local Government Act 1960;
- "Collection Day" means the day on which rubbish and refuse is collected and removed by the Local Authority or its contractor;
- "Principal Environmental Health Officer" means the Principal Environmental Health Officer of the Local Authority;
- "Receptacle" means a polyethylene cart fitted with wheels, a handle and a lid supplied by the Local Authority or its contractor, or other type of receptacle approved by the Local Authority;
- "Recyclable Material" means any material which can be reprocessed and reused and is nominated for collection under a recycling scheme by the Local Authority;
- "Street Alignment" has the meaning given to it in and for the purposes of the Local Government Act 1960.
- 13. Refuse to be deposited in receptacles
 - (1) The occupier of every premises where a receptacle has been provided shall—
 - (a) subject to paragraph (c) hereof cause all refuse to be deposited in a receptacle:
 - (b) at all times keep the lid of the receptacle closed except when depositing refuse in or cleaning the receptacle;
 - (c) not deposit or permit to be deposited in a receptacle—
 - (i) any material being or consisting of-
 - (A) hot or burning ashes;
 - (B) oil;
 - (C) liquid;
 - (D) paint;
 - (E) solvent;
 - (F) bricks, concrete, earth or other like substances;
 - (G) asbestos or asbestos products;
 - (H) hazardous products;
 - (I) material likely to become offensive or a nuisance or to give off an
 offensive or noxious odour unless it is first wrapped in absorbent
 or impervious material;
 - (J) ammunition;
 - (K) flares.
 - (ii) heavy material;
 - (iii) an object which is greater in length, width or breadth than the corresponding dimensions of the receptacle or which will not allow the lid of the receptacle to be closed.
 - (d) except on collection day keep the receptacle on the premises and located behind the building line or in a position approved by the Principal Environmental Health Officer;
 - (e) on collection day-
 - (i) place the receptacle on the street kerb adjacent to the premises but so that it does not obstruct a footpath, cycleway or other carriageway;
 - (ii) following removal of the contents of the receptacle place the receptacle on the premises behind the building line or in a position approved by the Principal Environmental Health Officer;

- (f) at all times keep the receptacle clean and whenever directed by the Principal Environmental Health Officer cleanse and disinfect the receptacle;
- (g) notify the Principal Environmental Health Officer within 7 days of the receptacle being lost, stolen, damaged or becoming defective;
- (h) (i) not mark or disfigure the receptacle in any manner other than by the placement thereon of a street or unit number or a street name in the manner approved by the Local Authority;
 - (ii) not use the receptacle for any purpose other than the collection of refuse and rubbish.
- (2) The Principal Environmental Health Officer may direct that refuse derived from the manufacture, preparation or sale of food or any putrescible waste from premises shall be collected and removed more often than in accordance with the prescribed periods referred to in By-laws 15(2) and 15(3).

14. The property in receptacles

A receptacle supplied by the Local Authority or its contractor remains the property of the Local Authority or its contractor as the case may be.

15. Collection of refuse

- (1) A person shall not unless he is authorised by the Local Authority so to do remove any refuse or rubbish from any premises in the district.
- (2) The Local Authority shall execute and continue the removal of household and general refuse from premises within the district at least once per fortnight provided that the waste to be collected is contained in an approved receptacle but the provisions of this clause do not apply to multiple dwelling unit sites and food premises.
- (3) Notwithstanding By-law 15(2), any occupier upon request shall receive a weekly collection of waste subject to the payment of prescribed fees as referred to in 15A(3).
- (4) The Local Authority or its contractor shall cause all refuse and rubbish collected and removed to be taken to a material recycling facility or an approved landfill site.

15A. Additional collections

- (1) Where the Local Authority provides a collection for recyclable material the occupier of premises shall comply with and observe the directions given by the Local Authority in relation to that collection.
- (2) Where the Local Authority provides a collection for bulk material the occupier of premises shall comply with and observe the directions given by the Local Authority in relation to that collection.
- (3) Where additional collection services are provided upon request by the occupier of premises, fees as prescribed by the Local Authority shall be paid.
- (4) The Local Authority may set a maximum weight of rubbish and refuse that may be placed in a receptacle and receptacles containing more than the maximum weight of refuse and rubbish shall not be cleared by the Local Authority or its contractor.

Prescribed area

The whole of the district of the Local Authority is prescribed as the area within which the provisions of Section 112A of the Health Act 1911 shall operate and have effect.

3. By-law 18 of Part 1 of the Principal By-laws is amended by deleting "cart" in line 2 and substituting "collection vehicle".

NOTICE TO ALL OWNERS/OCCUPIERS OF LAND WITHIN THE CITY OF SUBIACO

Firebreak or Removal of Flammable Materials Order 1995/96

Pursuant to the powers contained in Section 33 of the Bush Fires Act 1954, owners and/or occupiers of property within the City of Subiaco are hereby required on or before the 30 November 1995, and thereafter to the 31 March 1996, or within fourteen (14) days of the date of becoming owner or occupier. Should this be after the 30 November 1995, to maintain a firebreak or remove flammable material as follows—

PROHIBITION OF ENTRY INTO A SAFETY ZONE


I, Samuel George Ernest Cash, Minister for Mines, in the State of Western Australia and pursuant to section 112A of the above Act, hereby prohibit all vessels other than vessels under control of the registered holders of Exploration Permit EP 325 from entering or remaining in the area of the safety zone without the consent in writing of the Director, Petroleum Operations Division. This safety zone extends to a distance of five hundred metres, measured from each point of the outer edge of the drilling rig 'Harvey H Ward', whilst conducting petroleum operations at the Spider No. 1 well location (latitude 21°49'38.84" South, longitude 114°36'51.81" East.)

Where an unauthorised vessel enters or remains in the safety zone specified in contravention of this instrument, the owner and the person in command or in charge of the vessel are each guilty of an offence against section 112A of the Act and are punishable, upon conviction, by a fine not exceeding \$100 000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 10 years, or both, pursuant to section 112A (3) of the Act.
