FISH RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994

SHARK BAY PRAWN MANAGEMENT PLAN AMENDMENT 1996

FD 146/75

Made by the Minister under section 54.

Citation

1. This amendment may be cited as the Shark Bay Prawn Management Plan Amendment 1996.

Principal Plan

2. In this Plan the Shark Bay Prawn Management Plan 1993* is referred to as the principal plan.

Clause 13 amended

- 3. Clause 13 of the principal Plan is amended in subclause (4) by—
 - (a) deleting "7 March" and substituting the following—
 - " 12 March "; and
 - (b) deleting "17 April" and substituting the following—
 - " 12 April ".

Clause 14 repealed

- 4. Clause 14 of the principal Plan is repealed and the following clause substituted—
- " 14. (1) Subject to subclause (2) a person shall not allow more than 6 persons to be on an authorised boat at any one time.
 - (2) The Executive Director may, at any time, by advice in writing to the licensee, permit up to 8 persons to be on an authorised boat at any one time for a specified period.
 - (3) A person who contravenes—
 - (a) a provision of subclause (1); or
 - (b) a provision or condition of an advice issued pursuant to subclause (2),

commits an offence and for the purposes of section 75 of the Act these are major provisions. ".

CREDIT ACT 1984

Order under Section 19

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as Credit Order No. 100—Commonwealth Bank Repayment Redraw Facility.

Commencement

2. This Order shall take effect on and from the date of its publication in the *Government Gazette*.

Exemption

- 3. Subject to paragraph 4 hereof Parts III to VIII of the Credit Act do not have effect in relation to a facility which the Commonwealth Bank of Australia calls a Repayment Redraw Facility.
- 4. This Order applies only if the Repayment Redraw Facility is provided by the Commonwealth Bank of Australia to a debtor, who has a Housing Loan Contract with the Commonwealth Bank to Australia, and—
 - (a) the amount of credit available under the facility at any time does not exceed the total of—
 - (i) the amount of repayments made in excess of those required by the debtor's Housing Loan Contract; and
 - (ii) any savings arising from those extra repayments in interest which would otherwise have been charged to the amount;
 - (b) the credit provided under the facility is recorded in the debtor's Housing Loan Account;
 - (c) the interest rate on the facility does not exceed the interest rate applying to the debtor's Housing Loan Account; and
 - (d) the facility terminates when the debtor's Housing Loan Account is repaid.
- 5. For the purposes of this Order—
 - (a) "Housing Loan Contract" has the same meaning as in the Credit (Housing Loan Contracts) Order No. 1 of 1985; and
 - (b) "Housing Loan Account" means the account kept by the Commonwealth Bank of Australia under a Housing Loan Contract.

MEDICAL ACT 1894

In the matter of the Medical Act 1894 and amendments and in the matter of an inquiry with reference to the conduct of Dr Craig Stephen White.

The Medical Board of Western Australia held an Inquiry on the 28th February 1996 into an allegation that Dr Craig Stephen White may be—

- (a) guilty of infamous or improper conduct pursuant to Section 13 (1) (a) of the Medical 1894 as amended, and
- (b) affected by a dependence on or addiction to deleterious drug(s) pursuant to Section 13 (1) (b) of the Medical Act 1894 as amended.

The charges related to allegations that Dr Craig Stephen White—

- (1) In the period from October to November 1994, forged prescription forms in the name of another practitioner, prescribing Proladone to himself which he self-administered without lawful cause or authority, and
- (2) In or about June 1995 he presented at a pharmacy with a charge card in the name of another practitioner and attempted to obtain a drug of addiction, namely pethidine, at time when his prescribing rights conferred by the Poisons Act were revoked.

Dr White pleaded guilty to the charges and the Board heard Ms Carmel McLure, Counsel for the Board and Ms P. M. Malcolm, Counsel for Dr White and found as follows—

- (A) Dr Craig Stephen White was guilty of infamous conduct and suspended from the Register of Medical Practitioners for three (3) months.
- (B) At the expiry of the three (3) month suspension, Dr White should only be permitted to practise upon giving an undertaking to be of good behaviour for a period of two (2) years and then on the following conditions—
 - (1) Within seven (7) days from 28th February 1996, Dr White gives an undertaking to the Board to be of good behaviour for a period of two (2) years and three (3) months ("the period")
 - (2) Upon the expiration of the three (3) month suspension and thereafter for the next two (2) years, Dr White shall not within "the period"—
 - (i) prescribe or otherwise provide any person any drug listed in the 8th Schedule of the Poisons Act 1964 Schedule 8 drugs;
 - (ii) seek, request or obtain access to Schedule 8 drugs;
 - (iii) provided that (ii) above shall not restrict an independent registered medical practitioner from administering to Dr White a Schedule 8 drug for a diagnosed medical condition or in an emergency situation.
 - (3) If Dr White practises medicine within "the period"—
 - (i) He shall only work in such practice or situation as may be approved in writing by the
 - (ii) He shall inform the Board in writing from time to time of the name and addresses of his employer or employers or associate or associates;
 - (iii) He shall advise employer, employers, associate or associates in writing of the conditions (1) and (2) hereof.
 - (4) Dr White shall not within "the period" engage in the practise of medicine as a sole medical practitioner.

- (5) In order to enable the Board to be satisfied that Dr White has complied with conditions (1) and (2) hereof, he shall within the period—
 - (a) attend regularly upon a registered medical practitioner approved in writing by the Board, who will, at 3 monthly intervals, provide a report in writing to Dr White's general physical wellbeing. Dr White shall provide written permission for the medical practitioner to provide reports to the Board.
 - (b) attend on a medical officer nominated by the Board 3 times per week or as otherwise directed by the Board to provide a urine sample under supervision. Dr White shall provide written permission for the nominated medical officer to provide the reports referred to in (4) hereof. The medical officer shall be responsible for—
 - (i) organising urine scans on a frequency determined by the Board, utilising the procedures adopted by the Western Australian Alcohol and Drug Authority;
 - (ii) arranging for the State Health Laboratory or some other nominated institution to conduct a full drug screen of the sample;
 - (iii) receiving the result of the screening; and
 - (iv) providing a written report to the Board every 3 months on the results to the screening program.
 - (c) Attend upon the psychiatrist Dr Malcolm Roberts or some other psychiatrist approved by the Board for treatment and/or counselling, who will, at 3 monthly intervals, provide a written report to the Board as to Dr White's condition and progress. Dr White shall provide written permission for the psychiatrist to provide the reports.
- (6) Dr White shall forthwith formally acknowledge in writing that a breach of any one or more of the abovementioned conditions or any parts thereof may result in further action being taken against him pursuant to Section 13 of the Medical Act 1894.
- (7) Dr White was ordered to pay the costs of the Inquiry.
