Provided however that such revocation shall only apply from Middle Swan Bridge to Bells Rapids and Posselts Ford to Northam Weir between the hours of 0800 and 1800 on Saturday, 27 and Sunday, 28 July 1996 and is applicable only to those bona fide entrants of the 1996 Coates Hire Avon Descent participating in practice for that event and only during allocated practice times defined by the Northam Avon Descent Association in accordance with the event rules.
