#### FIREBREAK NOTICE

Notice to All Owners and/or Occupiers of Land in the Shire of Denmark

Firebreaks and Clearing of Inflammable Material to be in place by 1st December 1996

Pursuant to the powers contained in Section 33 of the above Act, you are hereby required on or before the 1st December 1996 to and including the 22nd May 1997 to have a firebreak, clear of inflammable material to comply with—

#### 1. URBAN LAND (LAND THAT IS RESIDENTIAL)

- 1.1 On land which is 0.25ha or less, remove inflammable material from the whole of the land.
- 1.2 On land which exceeds 0.25ha, clear firebreaks to at least 3 metres immediately inside all external boundaries of the land and immediately surrounding all buildings situated on the land
- 1.3 On Weedon Hill all land is required to have a 3 metre wide firebreak clear of inflammable material immediately inside all external boundaries of the land and immediately surrounding all buildings situated on the land and unoccupied land the remaining fuel to be reduced by clearing and removing of undergrowth. i.e. No dry materials should be left on the property.
- NB: For the purpose of this notice, inflammable material does not include live standing trees, cultivated plants or a maintained garden. However, all cut material should be removed from the land, so that a greater hazard is not created.

#### 2. RURAL LAND (NON-RESIDENTIAL)

- 2.1 Firebreaks—Rural Areas—
  - (a) Uncleared properties greater than 10 hectares be required to have boundary firebreaks.
  - (b) Uncleared areas greater than 40 hectares be provided with internal fire access tracks to form lots no greater than 40 hectares.
  - (c) Uncleared properties greater than 10 hectares will be boundary firebreaked to a width of no less than 6 metres and divided into lots no greater than 40 hectares by internal access breaks of a width of no less than 4 metres.

Boundary firebreaks are not compulsory within the Shire of Denmark rural area. Land holders can provide boundary firebreaks if they wish.

## 3. HOMESTEADS, BUILDINGS, HAYSTACKS, BULK FUEL, DRUMS AND LIQUID PETROLEUM

From the 1st December 1996, to and including the 22nd May 1997, you shall install a 4 metre firebreak clear of inflammable material around the whole of any or all the above items.

- 3.1 (a) All private access tracks to be of sufficient width and condition to allow entry and exit of a heavy duty fire unit.
  - (b) Sufficient room to be provided to turn a heavy duty fire unit at the end of all access tracks; i.e. a cul-de-sac or ring road to be provided.

#### 4. STRATEGIC FIRE ACCESS TRACKS—RURAL LAND

- 4.1 Strategic Fire Access Tracks apply to all rural land.
- 4.2 All Strategic Fire Access Tracks are to be a minimum of 4 metres wide, variations shall be carried out in conjunction with the Local Fire Brigade.
- 4.3 Access Tracks are to be maintained in a trafficable condition.
- 4.4 If an Access Track is located on your property you will be required to install and maintain it in conjunction with your Local Fire Brigade by the 1st December 1996, to the 22nd May 1997.
- 4.5 All Strategic Fire Access Tracks must be maintained by the landowner where a Strategic Access Track is located on that property.
- NB: Contact your Local Brigade or Shire for locations of Strategic Fire Access Tracks.

#### 5. HARDWOOD/SOFTWOOD PLANTATIONS LESS THAN 3 HA's

- (a) 6 metre wide firebreak clear of inflammable material around all boundaries of the plantations.
- (b) All firebreaks to be maintained in a trafficable condition and trees to be progressively pruned to maintain an unrestricted access of 4 metres.
- (c) Where SEC power lines pass over plantation areas, firebreak to be in accordance with SEC specifications and are to be complied with whole.
- (d) Where 3 or more plantations of less than 3 ha's are in one fire brigade area, they will be required to purchase adequate fire units for that area's brigades.

#### 6. FIRE PROTECTION OF HARDWOOD/SOFTWOOD PLANTATIONS

- (a) Plantation: Any area of planted pines or eucalyptus species 3 ha or more.
- (b) Firebreak for Plantations: 15 metre boundary break: i.e. The first row of trees must be 15 metres from the outside edge of the firebreak. The outer 10 metres must be clear of any flammable material on the ground and will have a 10 metre vertical clearance. The remaining 5 metres must be maintained with only low fuel.

#### 6.1 Minimum Firebreak Standards

- (a) 15 metre firebreak (as defined in 6(b)) on all boundaries of plantations that adjoin first class public road i.e. road subject to heavy traffic.
- (b) 10 metre wide firebreak clear of inflammable material should adjoin secondary road i.e. roads subject to low traffic.
- (c) 6 metre wide firebreak clear of inflammable material should surround compartments of approximately 30 hectares.
- (d) All firebreaks to be maintained in a trafficable condition and trees on both sides of the breaks to be progressively pruned to maintain an unrestricted access of 4 metres.
- (e) Where SEC power lines pass over plantation areas, firebreaks in accordance with SEC specifications are to be complied with.

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

#### Please Note

The penalty for failing to comply with this notice is a fine of not more than \$1 000 and a person in default is also liable whether prosecuted or not, to pay the cost of performing the work directed in this notice, if it is not carried out by the owner or occupier by the date required by this notice.

If it is considered to be impracticable for any reason to clear firebreaks as required by this notice you may apply to Council or its duly authorised officer no later than the 15th November 1996, for permission to provide firebreaks in alternative positions on the land. If permission is not granted by Council or its duly authorised officer, you shall comply with the requirements of this notice.

#### Fire Fighting Equipment

Council encourages landowner/occupiers of land greater than 2 hectares in area to have on that land or immediate access to an engine powered pumping unit and a tank with not less than 200 litres of water. It is anticipated that permits to burn during the restricted burning period will require such a unit on site.

#### THE FOLLOWING IS TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE FIREBREAK ORDER

No fires to be lit during the prohibited burning period from the 1st January 1997, to the 29th February 1997.

No fires may be lit during the restricted burning periods from 19th November 1996, to 31st December 1996, and the 1st March 1997, to 12th April 1997, without first obtaining a permit from a Fire Control Officer.

If in doubt, contact your Fire Control Officer or the Shire Office.

#### DATES TO REMEMBER

Restricted Burning Periods—18th November 1996, to 31st December 1996. 1st March 1997, to 12th April 1997.

Prohibited Burning Period—1st January 1997, to 29th February 1997.

# WESTERN AUSTRALIAN TROTTING ASSOCIATION RULES OF TROTTING

#### Notice of Amendment

Notice is hereby given that at a meeting of the Committee of the Western Australia Trotting Association held at Gloucester Park, East Perth, on the 24th day of September 1996, it was resolved by an absolute majority of the members of the Committee that the Rules of Trotting be amended as follows:

#### PART 3 STEWARDS

Delete existing Rule 15 and insert Rule 15:

#### **Duration Of Powers**

15. Except where these Rules otherwise provide, the powers of the Stewards in respect of all matters concerning any race meeting shall commence at the time of nominations of horses and drivers. Those powers shall continue for all purposes relating to any matter connected with or arising out of any race meeting until that matter is resolved.

#### PART 4

#### POWERS OF ENTRY OF AUTHORISED OFFICER UPON LAND

Delete existing Rule 27 and 27(f), and insert Rule 27, 27(f) and 27(g):

#### **Power To Enter Premises**

27. An authorised officer may at any time enter upon land owned or occupied by a licensed or registered person or occupied by permission, lien or license of a licensed or registered person or where registered horses are kept for any purpose following:

- 27(f) for any purpose which may reasonably assist in determining whether an offence against these Rules is being or has been committed or whether any condition of any license or registration issued or permission granted by the Controlling Body has been or is being breached, and for such purpose to take and impound or take into custody or remove any object or thing or to retain the same for use as evidence;
- 27(g) for the purpose of keeping of a horse, which is nominated to race, under surveillance and to remain with the horse until it races or as otherwise determined by the Chairman of Stewards or Controlling Body.

#### PART 14 ENTRY AND ACCEPTANCE

Insert Rule 165A.

#### Horse Omitted From Handicaps And/Or Draw For Barrier Positions

- 165A. (a) If, after the declaration of acceptances for a race, it is the opinion of the Stewards that an error or omission on the part of an employee of the Controlling Body caused a horse properly nominated for the race to be omitted from the handicaps and/or not correctly included in the draw for barrier position, the horse may be included in the handicaps and/or draw for barrier positions under the provisions of this rule.
  - (b) A horse included in the handicaps under the provision of part (a) of this rule shall be considered by the Handicapper in accordance with the field selection criteria set down by the Controlling Body.
  - (c) In the event of a horse included in a race under the provisions of part (a) of this rule causing a horse already declared as an acceptor for the race to be balloted, all other horses declared as acceptor's for the race shall take their relative barrier positions as if the horse balloted had not been included in the draw for barrier positions.
  - (d) Allocation of a barrier position to the horse included in the race and/or the draw for barrier positions under the provisions of part (a) of this rule, shall be in accordance with the conditions of the race for which the horse is declared an acceptor. The barrier position allocated to the horse shall be determined from the total number of barrier positions from which the horse is entitled to start, and the barrier position of a horse displaced by the horse and all horses drawn outside the displaced horse, shall increment by one barrier position.

- (e) The nomination of a horse shall not be considered for inclusion in the handicaps and/or inclusion in the draw for barrier positions under the provisions of part (a) of this rule, after 10.00 am on the day following the declaration of acceptances for the race or after the time for the declaration of acceptances for the race has been extended.
- (f) Any person, who in the opinion of the Stewards attempts to cause, or causes a horse to be improperly omitted from the handicaps and/or draw for barrier positions, commits an offence and may be penalised accordingly.
- (g) A person who owns or trains a horse declared as an acceptor for a race may make application to the Controlling Body to withdraw the horse from the race free of penalty if the person is aggrieved by the decision to include a horse in the race and/or draw for barrier positions under the provisions of part (a) of this rule.

Delete Rule 197 and insert:

#### No Liability

- 197. (a) Notwithstanding that a horse, ineligible to run or prohibited from running in a race, has run, or been permitted to run in the race and irrespective of whether or not the horse has won or been placed in the race or any stake has been paid or awarded neither the Controlling Body nor the Club or Body conducting the meeting shall thereby incur or be under any liability of any kind whatsoever to any person.
  - (b) When a horse is properly nominated for a race is omitted from the handicaps and/or not properly included in the draw for barrier positions due to an error or omission by an employee of the Controlling Body neither the Controlling Body nor the Club or Body conducting the meeting shall thereby incur or be under any liability of any kind whatsoever to any person.
  - (c) Each and every entry for a race shall be, and be deemed to be made subject to the provisions of this Rule.

#### BETTING CONTROL AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No. 2) 1996

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

#### Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Betting Control Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 1996.

#### Regulation 2 amended

- 2. Regulation 2 of the Betting Control Regulations 1978\* is amended by deleting "Acts Amendment (Racing and Betting) Act 1995" and substituting the following —
- " Acts Amendment (Racing and Betting Legislation) Act 1995 ".

# Twelfth Report 1995

## **Competition Policy**

In January 1996 the Standing Committee on Uniform Legislation and Intergovernmental Agreements reported on the implications for State law of the controversial Hilmer reforms, and said it would be unacceptable if the privatisation of former government business agencies left customers worse off.

This report is now available. The report calls for a comprehensive set of consumer safeguards to be introduced to privatised and corporatised governments agencies providing basic services to customers.

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
