## JUNE QUARTER 1996 LOAN COUNCIL ALLOCATION

Since 1993-94, the Australian Loan Council has overseen the borrowings of State, Territory and Commonwealth governments using a system of Loan Council Allocations (LCAs). LCAs are based on net borrowings as indicated by a government's deficit/surplus position.

The deficit/surplus is adjusted by memorandum items, the main purpose of which is to capture transactions which have some of the characteristics of borrowings, but are not fully reflected in the government's deficit/surplus. Other memorandum items improve comparability across jurisdictions and include local government borrowings.

Loan Council requires each government to publish quarterly LCA progress reports. Below is Western Australia's estimated LCA outcome for the June quarter and the year ending 30 June 1996.

The full year general government surplus was boosted by the sale of BankWest in the December quarter.

Significant capital spending on major infrastructure projects by the public trading enterprises sector increased the seasonal June quarter deficit. Overall increases in capital spending in the sector (on assets expected to generate future revenue) brought an annual turn around in the sector from a budgeted surplus (\$10 million) to a net financing requirement (NFR) deficit of \$89 million for 1995-96.

The estimated change in the net present value of operating leases over the year accounts for the large variation in budget time and annual outturn for the memorandum items.
