Order Directing the Removal of an Unauthorised Structure from Public Lands (Section 164A)

To: Mark Maurice Barnden and Kerry Lee Barnden, C/- Post Office Box 146, Lancelin, 6044, being the persons residing and in occupation or control of the beach shack and associated structures described below ("the structures").

At: The structures situated on Reserve No. 43283 Melbourne Location 4153 ("the Reserve") as depicted with the number "W.97/W.97a" on Plan No. 1927 prepared by the Department of Conservation and Land Management ("CALM").

Whereas:

Pursuant to sections 164A and 164B of the Act you are hereby directed not later than 104 days after the date of publication of this notice in the *Government Gazette* ("the due date") to remove the structures permanently together with the contents thereof and any materials objects and fixtures in the area of the structures from the Reserve.

Pursuant to section 164AA of the Act you may apply in writing to the Executive Director, CALM not later than 21 days before the due date for an extension of time not exceeding forty five (45) days within which the structures or any contents of those structures or materials, objects or fixtures in the area of those structures are to be removed.
- 3. So much of the structures, the contents thereof or any materials, objects or fixtures in the area of the structures the subject of this notice which have not been removed from the Reserve as at the due date or the date specified in an extension (if any) referred to in paragraph 2 above shall thereupon become the property of the Crown and may thereafter be removed destroyed or disposed of in such manner as the Executive Director, CALM thinks fit.
